A RESOLUTION

Designating Cardiac Amyloidosis Recognition Day in Ohio, November 14, 2019.

WHEREAS, The members of the House of Representatives of the 133rd General Assembly of Ohio are pleased to designate November 14, 2019, as Cardiac Amyloidosis Recognition Day in Ohio; and

WHEREAS, Amyloidosis is a group of diseases in which amyloid fibrils build up in the body's tissues and organs, including the heart, and ultimately lead to progressive organ dysfunction and other complications. Two of these diseases that affect the heart are immunoglobulin light chain amyloidosis and transthyretin amyloid cardiomyopathy, the latter of which has two sub-types, and these rare, life-threatening maladies are associated with heart failure, manifesting such symptoms as shortness of breath, fatigue, swelling of the legs, and angina; and

WHEREAS, Because cardiac amyloidosis is rare, awareness of 13 the condition is low, and no guidelines have been established on 14 the standard of care. Less than half of cardiologists have 15 reported being familiar with the tools and tests used to confirm 16 cardiac amyloidosis, including kidney biopsies, rectal biopsies, 17 scintigraphy, and genetic testing, and most patients with the 18 disease either never receive a proper diagnosis or remain 19 undiagnosed for years after symptoms become severe; and 20

WHEREAS, Once heart failure starts, patients with cardiac21amyloidosis who remain untreated have an average life expectancy22of only a few months, but those who receive a proper diagnosis and23treatment can increase life expectancy to several years. In24addition, such patients may have to overcome such hurdles as lack25of screening and inadequate health insurance coverage for both26

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diagnosis and treatment. These barriers demonstrate the importance	27
of awareness of these diseases; therefore be it	28
RESOLVED, That we, the members of the House of	29
Representatives of the 133rd General Assembly of Ohio, in adopting	30
this Resolution, designate November 14, 2019, as Cardiac	31
Amyloidosis Recognition Day in Ohio and encourage all citizens to	32
become informed and aware of the diseases and their symptoms, to	33
back efforts to educate healthcare providers about symptoms and	34
diagnosis, and to support funding for programs that reduce	35
barriers to screening and provide coverage for diagnosis and	36
