BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF OHIO:	
WHEREAS, Pollinators such as bees and butterflies are a	4
critical component to Ohio's ecological system and crucial to	5
agricultural production; and	6
WHEREAS, The population of these pollinators has	7
dramatically declined for various reasons, including habitat	8
loss. For example, more than 97% of the western monarch	9
butterfly population has been lost in some regions of the United	10
States; and	11
WHEREAS, States have implemented various programs to	12
address these population declines, including roadside habitat	13
programs. The Ohio Department of Transportation has transformed	14
more than 800 acres of land along roads to attract monarch	15
butterflies and bees; and	16
WHEREAS, The Department's roadside habitat program not only	17
creates a healthy habitat for pollinators, it also reduces the	18
need to mow these areas. In 2019, the reduction in mowing saved	19
more than two million dollars; now therefore be it	20
