A RESOLUTION

Honoring Buckeye Lake on its One Hundred Twenty-fifth
Anniversary.

WHEREAS, The members of the Senate of the 133rd General
Assembly of Ohio are pleased to congratulate Buckeye Lake on the
celebration of its One Hundred Twenty-fifth Anniversary, May 21,
2019; and

WHEREAS, Created as a part of the Ohio and Erie Canal
project, Buckeye Lake was originally called the Licking Summit
Reservoir, and it served as a source of water for the canal before
the demise of the canal system. Renamed by the Ohio State
Legislature in 1894, the lake has since become a beloved
recreational location for generations of Ohioans, and its
contributions to our state's cultural heritage are truly
praiseworthy; and

WHEREAS, Named a state park in 1949, Buckeye Lake has
undergone great upheaval over the past one hundred twenty-five
years, but it has endured and has come to represent the natural
splendor of Ohio. Looking at the lake now with its proud history
of leisure and summertime fun, and knowing its origins as
swampland before the damming of the South Fork of the Licking
River, it is easy to see it as a representation of man's ability
to shape our environment to suit our needs without compromising
the wonder of our state; and

WHEREAS, It is impossible to celebrate the anniversary of
Buckeye Lake without paying tribute to the numerous individuals
who have helped preserve the beauty, and even the very existence,
of the lake. From the dedicated people who help keep the area
pristine to all those associated with the project to restore the

dam when the lake was in danger of dam failure, they have all 27
proven themselves to be exemplary Ohioans; therefore be it 28

RESOLVED, That we, the members of the Senate of the 133rd 29
General Assembly of Ohio, in adopting this Resolution, revel in 30
the One Hundred Twenty-fifth Anniversary of Buckeye Lake and look 31
