## BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

WHEREAS, If an abortion results in the live birth of an

infant, the infant is a legal person and must be entitled to all	5	
the protections of United States law available to a legal	6

WHEREAS, Any infant born alive after an abortion or within	8	
a hospital, clinic, or other facility should have the same claim	9	
to the protections of the law that would arise for any newborn	10	
or any person who comes to a hospital, clinic, or other facility	11	
for screening and treatment or otherwise becomes a patient		
within its care; and		
WHEREAS, Without special protection for infants born alive	14	
after an abortion provided in law, these infants are exposed to	15	
serious injury or harm and possible death; and	16	
WHEREAS, A Born-Alive Abortion Survivors Protection Act	17	
would provide the protections needed so that an infant born	18

alive after an abortion is treated as a legal person under, and	19	
is protected by, United States law; now therefore be it	20	
RESOLVED, That we, the members of the Senate of the 133rd	21
