BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 3.15 of the Revised Code be amended	8	
to read as follows:		
Sec. 3.15. (A) Except as otherwise provided in division	10

office:		
(1) Each member of the general assembly and each elected	13	
voting member of the state board of education shall be a resident		
of the district he <u>the member</u> represents.		
(2) Each judge and each elected officer of a court shall be a	16	
resident of the territory of that court.		

- As Reported by the House Ethics and Elections Committee (3) Each person holding an elective office of a political 18 subdivision shall be a resident of that political subdivision. 19 (4) Each member of a municipal legislative authority who 20 represents a ward shall be a resident of the ward he the member 21 represents, and each member of a board of education of a city 22 school district who represents a subdistrict shall be a resident 23 of the subdistrict he the member represents. 24 (B) Any person who is elected by members of a caucus of the 25 general assembly to fill a vacancy in the senate or house of 26 representatives under Ohio Constitution, Article II, Section 11 27 shall have been a resident, for at least one year immediately 28 prior to the election by those members, of the district the person 29 is elected to represent, unless the person has been absent on the 30 public business of the United States or of this state. As used in 31 this division, "caucus" has the same meaning as in section 3517.01 32 Of the Revised Code. 33 (C) Any person who fails to meet any of the requirements of 34 division (A) or (B) of this section that apply to him the person 35 shall forfeit his the office. Division (A) of this section applies 36 to persons who have been either elected or appointed to an 37 elective office. Division (A) of this section does not apply to a 38 member of the general assembly or the state board of education, to 39 a member of a municipal legislative authority who represents a 40 ward, or to a member of a board of education of a city school 41 district who represents a subdistrict, during the remainder of his 42 the member's existing term of office after there is a change in 43 his the member's district's, ward's, or subdistrict's boundaries 44 that leaves his the member's permanent residence outside the 45 district, ward, or subdistrict. 46
