A B I L L

To amend section 101.82 of the Revised Code to exempt 1
the Industrial Commission from the list of agencies 2
reviewed by the Sunset Review Committee and to make 3
appropriations for the Industrial Commission for 4
the biennium beginning July 1, 2001, and ending 5
June 30, 2003. 6

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 101.82 of the Revised Code be amended 7
to read as follows: 8

Sec. 101.82. As used in sections 101.82 to 101.87 of the 9
Revised Code: 10

(A) "Agency" means any board, commission, committee, or 11
council, or any other similar state public body required to be 12
established pursuant to state statutes for the exercise of any 13
function of state government and to which members are appointed or 14
elected. "Agency" does not include: 15

(1) The general assembly, or any commission, committee, or 16
other body composed entirely of members thereof; 17

(2) Any court;	18
(3) Any public body created by or directly pursuant to the constitution of this state;	19 20
(4) The board of trustees of any institution of higher education financially supported in whole or in part by the state;	21 22
(5) Any public body that has the authority to issue bonds or notes or that has issued bonds or notes that have not been fully repaid;	23 24 25
(6) The public utilities commission of Ohio;	26
(7) The consumers' council governing board;	27
(8) The Ohio board of regents;	28
(9) Any state board or commission that has the authority to issue any final adjudicatory order that may be appealed to the court of common pleas under Chapter 119. of the Revised Code;	29 30 31
(10) Any board of elections;	32
(11) The board of directors of the Ohio insurance guaranty association and the board of governors of the Ohio fair plan underwriting association;	33 34 35
(12) The Ohio public employees deferred compensation board;	36
(13) The Ohio retirement study council;	37
(14) The board of trustees of the Ohio police and fire pension fund, public employees retirement board, school employees retirement board, state highway patrol retirement board, and state teachers retirement board;	38 39 40 41

(B) "Abolish" means to repeal the statutes creating and empowering an agency, remove its personnel, and transfer its records to the department of administrative services pursuant to	43 44 45

division (H) of section 149.331 of the Revised Code. 46

(C) "Terminate" means to amend or repeal the statutes 47
creating and empowering an agency, remove its personnel, and 48
reassign its functions and records to another agency or officer 49
designated by the general assembly. 50

(D) "Transfer" means to amend the statutes creating and 51
empowering an agency so that its functions, records, and personnel 52
are conveyed to another agency or officer. 53

(E) "Renew" means to continue an agency, and may include 54
amendment of the statutes creating and empowering the agency, or 55
recommendations for changes in agency operation or personnel. 56

Section 2. That existing section 101.82 of the Revised Code 57
is hereby repealed. 58

Section 3. All items in this section are appropriated out of 59
any moneys in the state treasury to the credit of the designated 60
fund. For all appropriations made in this section, those in the 61
first column are for fiscal year 2002, and those in the second 62
column are for fiscal year 2003. 63

The foregoing appropriation item 845-402, Rent - William 75
Green Building, shall be used for rent and operating expenses for 76
the space occupied by the Industrial Commission in the William 77
Green Building. 78

SERVICE ACCOUNT 79

The foregoing appropriation item 845-605, Service Account, 80
shall be used for any expense related to revenues collected and 81
deposited in Fund 821, such as coin copier expense, coin changer 82
purchases, expenses related to conferences that produce revenue, 83
publications that produce revenue, and replacement of furniture 84
and equipment. 85

Section 4. LAW GENERALLY APPLICABLE TO APPROPRIATIONS 86

Law contained in the main operating appropriations act of the 87
124th General Assembly that applies generally to the 88
appropriations made in that act also applies generally to the 89
appropriations made in this act. 90

Section 5. The uncodified sections of law contained in this 91
act, and the items of law of which the uncodified sections of law 92
contained in this act are composed, are not subject to the 93
referendum. Therefore, under Ohio Constitution, Article II, 94
Section 1d and section 1.471 of the Revised Code, the uncodified 95
sections of law contained in this act, and the items of law of 96
which the uncodified sections of law contained in this act are 97
composed, go into immediate effect when this act becomes law. 98

Section 6. An item that composes the whole or part of an 99
uncodified section contained in this act has no effect after June 100
30, 2003, unless its context clearly indicates otherwise. 101

Section 7. If any item of law that constitutes the whole or 102
part of an uncodified section of law contained in this act, or if 103
any application of any item of law that constitutes the whole or 104
part of an uncodified section of law contained in this act, is 105
held invalid, the invalidity does not affect other items of law or 106
applications of items of law that can be given effect without the 107
invalid item of law or application. To this end, the items of law 108
of which the uncodified sections of law contained in this act are 109
composed, and their applications, are independent and severable. 110
