**BILL SUMMARY**

- Exempts the Industrial Commission from the list of agencies reviewed by the Sunset Review Committee.

**CONTENT AND OPERATION**

**Sunset Review Committee**

Under current law, the Sunset Review Committee evaluates the usefulness, performance, and effectiveness of each agency under its review power for the purpose of stating its findings and proposing its recommendations to the Governor, the President of the Senate, the Speaker of the House of Representatives, and the affected agency. The bill removes the Industrial Commission from the list of agencies subject to review by the Sunset Review Committee. (Sec. 101.82(A).)
