Subject: House Bill 64 - Main Operating Budget FY2016-FY2017

As CEO of Lakota Industries Inc. and Lakota Archery LLC, I support the sensible fee increase as proposed by the ODNR Division of Wildlife and contained in House Bill 64.

Lakota recognizes that a direct financial benefit to the State of Ohio is a result of the quality of our Ohio deer herd. It provides out-of state hunters an unequaled opportunity to harvest a trophy animal.

Hunters often pay much higher fees in other states for an opportunity at much less quality animals. Non resident deer hunters respect and relish the opportunity to hunt in Ohio and will still consider the modest increase a good value.

Lakota Industries appreciates the significance of a financially strong ODNR Division of Wildlife. The ODNR is one of the few agencies in Ohio that supports itself through the initiatives of its management, dedicated sportsmen and women and USFWS as a result of Pittman-Robertson and Dingell-Johnson programs.

As a manufacturer of Archery Products and Hunting equipment I know the importance of the Federal excise tax administered by Pitman-Robertson. For future generation it is imperative that we keep our ODNR financially strong.

The recreational value that the ODNR provides and the mission of its staff cannot be understated.
