## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 3333.70 of the Revised Code be	4
enacted to read as follows:	5
Sec. 3333.70. (A) The chancellor of the Ohio board of	6
regents shall establish and administer the Ohio higher education	7
innovation grant program to promote educational excellence and	8
economic efficiency throughout the state in order to stabilize	9
or reduce student tuition rates at institutions of higher	10
education. Under the program, the chancellor shall award grants	11
to state institutions of higher education, as defined in section	12
3345.011 of the Revised Code, and private nonprofit institutions	13
for innovative projects that incorporate academic achievement	14
and economic efficiencies. State institutions of higher	15
education and private nonprofit institutions may apply for	16
grants and initiate collaboration with other institutions of	17
higher education, either public or private, on such projects.	18

(B) The chancellor shall adopt rules to administer the	19
program including, but not limited to, requirements that each	20
grant application provides for all of the following:	21
(1) A system by which to measure academic achievement and	22
reductions in expenditures, both in funding and administration;	23
(2) Demonstration of how the project will be sustained	24
beyond the grant period and continue to provide substantial	25
value and lasting impact;	26
(3) Proof of commitment from all parties responsible for	27
the implementation of the project;	28
(4) Implementation of an ongoing evaluation process and	29
improvement plans, as necessary.	30
(C) As used in this section, "private nonprofit	31
institution" means a nonprofit institution in this state that	32
has a certificate of authorization pursuant to Chapter 1713. of	33
the Revised Code.	34
Section 2. All items in this section are hereby	35
appropriated_as designated out of any moneys in the state	36
treasury to the_credit of the designated fund. For all	37
appropriations made in this_act, those in the first column are	38
for fiscal year $201\underline{6}$ and those_in the second column are for	39
fiscal year $201\overline{2}$ . The appropriations_made in this act are in	40
addition to any other appropriations made_for the FY $201\underline{6}$ -FY	41
