## A BILL

To enact section 3345.37 of the Revised Code with	1
regard to the selection, availability, and	2
purchase of textbooks that are required for a	3
course offered by any state institution of	4
higher education.	5

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 3345.37 of the Revised Code be	6
enacted to read as follows:	7
Sec. 3345.37. (A) For purposes of this section:	8
(1) "State institution of higher education" has the same	9
meaning as in section 3345.011 of the Revised Code.	10
(2) "Proprietary textbook" means a textbook that is used,	11
produced, or marketed under exclusive legal right of any state	12
institution of higher education or of a faculty member of any	13
state institution of higher education, and for which the faculty	14
member or institution earns royalties or other financial benefit	15
upon the textbook's purchase.	16
upon the textbook's purchase.	17

(3) "Customized textbook" means any customized educational	18
material, any combination of original manuscripts, published	19
journal articles, book excerpts, photographs, or illustrations,	20
including, but not limited to, course instructional materials	21
authored in part by the faculty member who assigned the	22
textbook.	23
(4) A course of instruction is "exclusively offered" by a	24
state institution of higher education when the subject matter of	25
the course is discrete, unique, and not offered by any other	26
state institution of higher education in the same or	27
substantially similar format or manner. A course of instruction	28
is not "exclusively offered" by a state institution of higher	29
education when the course is transferable as determined by the	30
chancellor of the Ohio board of regents or as provided for in	31
policies, procedures, or agreements adopted or entered into	32
under sections 3333.16, 3333.161, and 3333.162 of the Revised	33
Code.	34
(B)(1) No state institution of higher education shall	35
produce, publish, or require a student to purchase a proprietary	36
or customized textbook unless that textbook is required for a	37
course of instruction that is exclusively offered by the	38
institution.	39
(2) No faculty member of a state institution of higher	40
education shall require a student to purchase a proprietary	41
textbook or a customized textbook for use in that faculty	42
member's course of instruction unless the course of instruction	43
is exclusively offered by the institution.	44
(C) If a student is required to purchase or use a specific	45
textbook for a course offered by any state institution of higher	46
education, that textbook shall be made available for purchase	47

through at least two suppliers, one of which shall not be an	48
entity owned or affiliated with the institution. This division	49
does not apply to any textbook that is required for a course of	50
instruction that is exclusively offered by the institution.	51
