A BILL

To amend section 103.11 of the Revised Code 1
regarding the term of a General Assembly member 2
as a member of the Legislative Service 3
Commission. 4

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 103.11 of the Revised Code be 5
amended to read as follows: 6

Sec. 103.11. There is hereby created, in the legislative 7
branch of government, the Ohio legislative service commission 8
consisting of fourteen members as follows: six members shall be 9
members of the senate appointed by the president of the senate, 10
not more than four of whom shall be members of the same 11
political party; six members shall be members of the house of 12
representatives appointed by the speaker of the house of 13
representatives, not more than four of whom shall be members of 14
the same political party; the president of the senate; and the 15
speaker of the house of representatives. 16

The members of the commission ~~who are appointed from the~~ 17
~~membership of the senate and the house of representatives shall~~ 18

serve ~~during their term as a member~~ only so long as they are 19
members of the general assembly ~~and until their successors are~~ 20
~~appointed and qualified, notwithstanding the adjournment of the~~ 21
~~general assembly of which they are members or the expiration of~~ 22
~~their terms as members of such general assembly.~~ A vacancy in 23
the office of any member of the commission shall be filled for 24
the unexpired term in the same manner as the original 25
appointment. 26

The commission shall organize by selecting from its 27
membership a ~~chairman~~ chairperson and a vice ~~chairmen~~ 28
chairperson. 29

The members of the commission and members of committees 30
thereof shall serve without compensation but shall be reimbursed 31
for their actual and necessary expenses incurred in the 32
performance of their official duties. 33

Section 2. That existing section 103.11 of the Revised 34
Code is hereby repealed. 35
