A BILL

To amend section 4501.21 and to enact section 1
4503.873 of the Revised Code to create the 2
"Brecksville-Broadview Heights City Schools" 3
license plate. 4

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 4501.21 be amended and section 5
4503.873 of the Revised Code be enacted to read as follows: 6

Sec. 4501.21. (A) There is hereby created in the state 7
treasury the license plate contribution fund. The fund shall 8
consist of all contributions paid by motor vehicle registrants 9
and collected by the registrar of motor vehicles pursuant to 10
sections 4503.491, 4503.492, 4503.493, 4503.494, 4503.496, 11
4503.498, 4503.499, 4503.50, 4503.501, 4503.502, 4503.505, 12
4503.51, 4503.522, 4503.523, 4503.524, 4503.525, 4503.526, 13
4503.531, 4503.534, 4503.545, 4503.55, 4503.551, 4503.552, 14
4503.553, 4503.554, 4503.561, 4503.562, 4503.564, 4503.576, 15
4503.591, 4503.67, 4503.68, 4503.69, 4503.701, 4503.71, 16
4503.711, 4503.712, 4503.713, 4503.72, 4503.73, 4503.732, 17
4503.74, 4503.75, 4503.751, 4503.85, 4503.86, 4503.873, 4503.89, 18
4503.90, 4503.92, and 4503.94 of the Revised Code. 19

(B) The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar collects in the fund as follows:

The registrar shall pay the contributions received pursuant to section 4503.491 of the Revised Code to the breast cancer fund of Ohio, which shall use that money only to pay for programs that provide assistance and education to Ohio breast cancer patients and that improve access for such patients to quality health care and clinical trials and shall not use any of the money for abortion information, counseling, services, or other abortion-related activities.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.492 of the Revised Code to the organization cancer support community central Ohio, which shall deposit the money into the Sheryl L. Kraner Fund of that organization. Cancer support community central Ohio shall expend the money it receives pursuant to this division only in the same manner and for the same purposes as that organization expends other money in that fund.

The registrar shall pay the contributions received pursuant to section 4503.493 of the Revised Code to the autism society of Ohio, which shall use the contributions for programs and autism awareness efforts throughout the state.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.494 of the Revised Code to the national multiple sclerosis society for distribution in equal amounts to the northwestern Ohio, Ohio buckeye, and Ohio valley chapters of the national multiple sclerosis society. These chapters shall use the money they receive under this section to assist in paying the expenses they incur in providing services directly to their clients.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.496 of the Revised Code to the Ohio sickle cell and health association, which shall use the contributions to help support educational, clinical, and social support services for adults who have sickle cell disease.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.498 of the Revised Code to special olympics Ohio, inc., which shall use the contributions for its programs, charitable efforts, and other activities.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.499 of the Revised Code to the children's glioma cancer foundation, which shall use the contributions for its research and other programs.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.50 of the Revised Code to the future farmers of America foundation, which shall deposit the contributions into its general account to be used for educational and scholarship purposes of the future farmers of America foundation.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.501 of the Revised Code to the 4-H youth development program of the Ohio state university extension program, which shall use those contributions to pay the expenses it incurs in conducting its educational activities.

The registrar shall pay the contributions received pursuant to section 4503.502 of the Revised Code to the Ohio cattlemen's foundation, which shall use those contributions for scholarships and other educational activities.

The registrar shall pay the contributions received

pursuant to section 4503.505 of the Revised Code to the 79
organization Ohio region phi theta kappa, which shall use those 80
contributions for scholarships for students who are members of 81
that organization. 82

The registrar shall pay each contribution the registrar 83
receives pursuant to section 4503.51 of the Revised Code to the 84
university or college whose name or marking or design appears on 85
collegiate license plates that are issued to a person under that 86
section. A university or college that receives contributions 87
from the fund shall deposit the contributions into its general 88
scholarship fund. 89

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 90
receives pursuant to section 4503.522 of the Revised Code to the 91
"friends of Perry's victory and international peace memorial, 92
incorporated," a nonprofit corporation organized under the laws 93
of this state, to assist that organization in paying the 94
expenses it incurs in sponsoring or holding charitable, 95
educational, and cultural events at the monument. 96

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 97
receives pursuant to section 4503.523 of the Revised Code to the 98
fairport lights foundation, which shall use the money to pay for 99
the restoration, maintenance, and preservation of the 100
lighthouses of fairport harbor. 101

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 102
receives pursuant to section 4503.524 of the Revised Code to the 103
Massillon tiger football booster club, which shall use the 104
contributions only to promote and support the football team of 105
Washington high school of the Massillon city school district. 106

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 107

receives pursuant to section 4503.525 of the Revised Code to the 108
United States power squadron districts seven, eleven, twenty- 109
four, and twenty-nine in equal amounts. Each power squadron 110
district shall use the money it receives under this section to 111
pay for the educational boating programs each district holds or 112
sponsors within this state. 113

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 114
receives pursuant to section 4503.526 of the Revised Code to the 115
Ohio district Kiwanis foundation of the Ohio district of Kiwanis 116
international, which shall use the money it receives under this 117
section to pay the costs of its educational and humanitarian 118
activities. 119

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 120
receives pursuant to section 4503.531 of the Revised Code to the 121
thank you foundation, incorporated, a nonprofit corporation 122
organized under the laws of this state, to assist that 123
organization in paying for the charitable activities and 124
programs it sponsors in support of United States military 125
personnel, veterans, and their families. 126

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 127
receives pursuant to section 4503.534 of the Revised Code to the 128
disabled American veterans department of Ohio, to be used for 129
programs that serve disabled American veterans and their 130
families. 131

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 132
receives pursuant to section 4503.55 of the Revised Code to the 133
pro football hall of fame, which shall deposit the contributions 134
into a special bank account that it establishes and which shall 135
be separate and distinct from any other account the pro football 136
hall of fame maintains, to be used exclusively for the purpose 137

of promoting the pro football hall of fame as a travel 138
destination. 139

The registrar shall pay the contributions that are paid to 140
the registrar pursuant to section 4503.545 of the Revised Code 141
to the national rifle association foundation, which shall use 142
the money to pay the costs of the educational activities and 143
programs the foundation holds or sponsors in this state. 144

The registrar shall pay to the Ohio pet fund the 145
contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 146
4503.551 of the Revised Code and any other money from any other 147
source, including donations, gifts, and grants, that is 148
designated by the source to be paid to the Ohio pet fund. The 149
Ohio pet fund shall use the moneys it receives under this 150
section to support programs for the sterilization of dogs and 151
cats and for educational programs concerning the proper 152
veterinary care of those animals, and for expenses of the Ohio 153
pet fund that are reasonably necessary for it to obtain and 154
maintain its tax-exempt status and to perform its duties. 155

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 156
receives pursuant to section 4503.552 of the Revised Code to the 157
rock and roll hall of fame and museum, incorporated. 158

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 159
receives pursuant to section 4503.553 of the Revised Code to the 160
Ohio coalition for animals, incorporated, a nonprofit 161
corporation. Except as provided in division (B) of this section, 162
the coalition shall distribute the money to its members, and the 163
members shall use the money only to pay for educational, 164
charitable, and other programs of each coalition member that 165
provide care for unwanted, abused, and neglected horses. The 166
Ohio coalition for animals may use a portion of the money to pay 167

for reasonable marketing costs incurred in the design and 168
promotion of the license plate and for administrative costs 169
incurred in the disbursement and management of funds received 170
under this section. 171

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 172
receives pursuant to section 4503.554 of the Revised Code to the 173
Ohio state council of the knights of Columbus, which shall use 174
the contributions to pay for its charitable activities and 175
programs. 176

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 177
receives pursuant to section 4503.561 of the Revised Code to the 178
state of Ohio chapter of ducks unlimited, inc., which shall 179
deposit the contributions into a special bank account that it 180
establishes. The special bank account shall be separate and 181
distinct from any other account the state of Ohio chapter of 182
ducks unlimited, inc., maintains and shall be used exclusively 183
for the purpose of protecting, enhancing, restoring, and 184
managing wetlands and conserving wildlife habitat. The state of 185
Ohio chapter of ducks unlimited, inc., annually shall notify the 186
registrar in writing of the name, address, and account to which 187
such payments are to be made. 188

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 189
receives pursuant to section 4503.562 of the Revised Code to the 190
Mahoning river consortium, which shall use the money to pay the 191
expenses it incurs in restoring and maintaining the Mahoning 192
river watershed. 193

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 194
receives pursuant to section 4503.564 of the Revised Code to 195
Antioch college for the use of the Glen Helen ecology institute 196
to pay expenses related to the Glen Helen nature preserve. 197

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.576 of the Revised Code to the Ohio state beekeepers association, which shall use those contributions to promote beekeeping, provide educational information about beekeeping, and to support other state and local beekeeping programs.

The registrar shall pay to a sports commission created pursuant to section 4503.591 of the Revised Code each contribution the registrar receives under that section that an applicant pays to obtain license plates that bear the logo of a professional sports team located in the county of that sports commission and that is participating in the license plate program pursuant to division (E) of that section, irrespective of the county of residence of an applicant.

The registrar shall pay to a community charity each contribution the registrar receives under section 4503.591 of the Revised Code that an applicant pays to obtain license plates that bear the logo of a professional sports team that is participating in the license plate program pursuant to division (G) of that section.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.67 of the Revised Code to the Dan Beard council of the boy scouts of America. The council shall distribute all contributions in an equitable manner throughout the state to regional councils of the boy scouts.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.68 of the Revised Code to the great river council of the girl scouts of the United States of America. The council shall distribute all contributions in an equitable manner throughout the state to regional councils of

the girl scouts. 228

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 229
receives pursuant to section 4503.69 of the Revised Code to the 230
Dan Beard council of the boy scouts of America. The council 231
shall distribute all contributions in an equitable manner 232
throughout the state to regional councils of the boy scouts. 233

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 234
receives pursuant to section 4503.701 of the Revised Code to the 235
Prince Hall grand lodge of free and accepted masons of Ohio, 236
which shall use the contributions for scholarship purposes. 237

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 238
receives pursuant to section 4503.71 of the Revised Code to the 239
fraternal order of police of Ohio, incorporated, which shall 240
deposit the fees into its general account to be used for 241
purposes of the fraternal order of police of Ohio, incorporated. 242

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 243
receives pursuant to section 4503.711 of the Revised Code to the 244
fraternal order of police of Ohio, incorporated, which shall 245
deposit the contributions into an account that it creates to be 246
used for the purpose of advancing and protecting the law 247
enforcement profession, promoting improved law enforcement 248
methods, and teaching respect for law and order. 249

The registrar shall pay the contributions received 250
pursuant to section 4503.712 of the Revised Code to Ohio 251
concerns of police survivors, which shall use those 252
contributions to provide whatever assistance may be appropriate 253
to the families of Ohio law enforcement officers who are killed 254
in the line of duty. 255

The registrar shall pay the contributions received 256

pursuant to section 4503.713 of the Revised Code to the greater 257
Cleveland peace officers memorial society, which shall use those 258
contributions to honor law enforcement officers who have died in 259
the line of duty and support its charitable purposes. 260

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 261
receives pursuant to section 4503.72 of the Revised Code to the 262
organization known on March 31, 2003, as the Ohio CASA/GAL 263
association, a private, nonprofit corporation organized under 264
Chapter 1702. of the Revised Code. The Ohio CASA/GAL association 265
shall use these contributions to pay the expenses it incurs in 266
administering a program to secure the proper representation in 267
the courts of this state of abused, neglected, and dependent 268
children, and for the training and supervision of persons 269
participating in that program. 270

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 271
receives pursuant to section 4503.73 of the Revised Code to 272
Wright B. Flyer, incorporated, which shall deposit the 273
contributions into its general account to be used for purposes 274
of Wright B. Flyer, incorporated. 275

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 276
receives pursuant to section 4503.732 of the Revised Code to the 277
Siegel & Shuster society, a nonprofit organization dedicated to 278
commemorating and celebrating the creation of Superman in 279
Cleveland, Ohio. 280

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 281
receives pursuant to section 4503.74 of the Revised Code to the 282
Columbus zoological park association, which shall disburse the 283
moneys to Ohio's major metropolitan zoos, as defined in section 284
4503.74 of the Revised Code, in accordance with a written 285
agreement entered into by the major metropolitan zoos. 286

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.75 of the Revised Code to the rotary foundation, located on March 31, 2003, in Evanston, Illinois, to be placed in a fund known as the permanent fund and used to endow educational and humanitarian programs of the rotary foundation.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.751 of the Revised Code to the Ohio association of realtors, which shall deposit the contributions into a property disaster relief fund maintained under the Ohio realtors charitable and education foundation.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.85 of the Revised Code to the Ohio sea grant college program to be used for Lake Erie area research projects.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.86 of the Revised Code to the Ohio Lincoln highway historic byway, which shall use those contributions solely to promote and support the historical preservation and advertisement of the Lincoln highway in this state.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.873 of the Revised Code to the Brecksville-Broadview Heights city school district. The school district shall use the contributions it receives to pay the expenses it incurs in providing services to the school district's students that assist in developing or maintaining the mental and emotional well-being of the students. The services provided may include bereavement counseling, instruction in defensive driving techniques, sensitivity training, and the

counseling and education of students regarding bullying, dating 317
violence, drug abuse, suicide prevention, and human trafficking. 318
The school district superintendent or, in the school district 319
superintendent's discretion, the appropriate school principal or 320
appropriate school counselors shall determine any charitable 321
organizations that the school district hires to provide those 322
services. The school district also may use the contributions it 323
receives to pay for members of the faculty of the school 324
district to receive training in providing such services to the 325
students of the school district. The school district shall 326
ensure that any charitable organization that is hired by the 327
district is exempt from federal income taxation under subsection 328
501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. The school district 329
shall not use the contributions it receives for any other 330
purpose. 331

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 332
receives pursuant to section 4503.89 of the Revised Code to the 333
American red cross of greater Columbus on behalf of the Ohio 334
chapters of the American red cross, which shall use the 335
contributions for disaster readiness, preparedness, and response 336
programs on a statewide basis. 337

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 338
receives pursuant to section 4503.90 of the Revised Code to the 339
nationwide children's hospital foundation. 340

The registrar shall pay the contributions received 341
pursuant to section 4503.92 of the Revised Code to support our 342
troops, incorporated, a national nonprofit corporation, which 343
shall use those contributions in accordance with its articles of 344
incorporation and for the benefit of servicemembers of the armed 345
forces of the United States and their families when they are in 346

financial need. 347

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 348
receives pursuant to section 4503.94 of the Revised Code to the 349
Michelle's leading star foundation, which shall use the money 350
solely to fund the rental, lease, or purchase of the simulated 351
driving curriculum of the Michelle's leading star foundation by 352
boards of education of city, exempted village, local, and joint 353
vocational school districts. 354

(C) All investment earnings of the license plate 355
contribution fund shall be credited to the fund. Not later than 356
the first day of May of every year, the registrar shall 357
distribute to each entity described in division (B) of this 358
section the investment income the fund earned the previous 359
calendar year. The amount of such a distribution paid to an 360
entity shall be proportionate to the amount of money the entity 361
received from the fund during the previous calendar year. 362

Sec. 4503.873. (A) The owner or lessee of any passenger 363
car, noncommercial motor vehicle, recreational vehicle, 364
motorcycle, cab-enclosed motorcycle, commercial motor vehicle, 365
or other vehicle of a class approved by the registrar of motor 366
vehicles, and, effective January 1, 2017, the owner or lessee of 367
any motor-driven cycle or motor scooter may apply to the 368
registrar for the registration of the vehicle and issuance of 369
"Brecksville-Broadview Heights City Schools" license plates. The 370
application for "Brecksville-Broadview Heights City Schools" 371
license plates may be combined with a request for a special 372
reserved license plate under section 4503.40 or 4503.42 of the 373
Revised Code. Upon receipt of the completed application and 374
compliance with division (B) of this section, the registrar 375
shall issue to the applicant the appropriate vehicle 376

registration and a set of "Brecksville-Broadview Heights City 377
Schools" license plates with a validation sticker or a 378
validation sticker alone when required by section 4503.191 of 379
the Revised Code. 380

In addition to the letters and numbers ordinarily 381
inscribed thereon, "Brecksville-Broadview Heights City Schools" 382
license plates shall bear words and markings selected by the 383
Brecksville-Broadview Heights city school district. The 384
registrar shall approve the final design. "Brecksville-Broadview 385
Heights City Schools" license plates shall bear county 386
identification stickers that identify the county of registration 387
by name or number. 388

(B) "Brecksville-Broadview Heights City Schools" license 389
plates and validation stickers shall be issued upon payment of 390
the regular license tax as prescribed under section 4503.04 of 391
the Revised Code, any applicable motor vehicle tax levied under 392
Chapter 4504. of the Revised Code, a bureau of motor vehicles 393
administrative fee of ten dollars, the contribution specified in 394
division (C) of this section, and compliance with all other 395
applicable laws relating to the registration of motor vehicles. 396
If the application for "Brecksville-Broadview Heights City 397
Schools" license plates is combined with a request for a special 398
reserved license plate under section 4503.40 or 4503.42 of the 399
Revised Code, the license plates and validation sticker shall be 400
issued upon payment of the contribution, fees, and taxes 401
contained in this division and the additional fee prescribed 402
under section 4503.40 or 4503.42 of the Revised Code. 403

(C) For each application for registration and registration 404
renewal submitted under this section, the registrar shall 405
collect a contribution of thirty dollars. The registrar shall 406

pay this contribution into the state treasury to the credit of 407
the license plate contribution fund created in section 4501.21 408
of the Revised Code. 409

The registrar shall pay the ten-dollar bureau 410
administrative fee, the purpose of which is to compensate the 411
bureau for additional services required in issuing "Brecksville- 412
Broadview Heights City Schools" license plates, into the state 413
treasury to the credit of the state bureau of motor vehicles 414
fund created in section 4501.25 of the Revised Code. 415

(D) Sections 4503.77 and 4503.78 of the Revised Code do 416
not apply to license plates issued under this section. 417

Section 2. That existing section 4501.21 of the Revised 418
Code is hereby repealed. 419
