BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 4501.21 be amended and section	4
4503.871 of the Revised Code be enacted to read as follows:	5
Sec. 4501.21. (A) There is hereby created in the state	6
treasury the license plate contribution fund. The fund shall	7
consist of all contributions paid by motor vehicle registrants	8
and collected by the registrar of motor vehicles pursuant to	9
sections 4503.491, 4503.492, 4503.493, 4503.494, 4503.496,	10
4503.498, 4503.499, 4503.50, 4503.501, 4503.502, 4503.505,	11
4503.51, 4503.522, 4503.523, 4503.524, 4503.525, 4503.526,	12
4503.531, 4503.534, 4503.545, 4503.55, 4503.551, 4503.552,	13
4503.553, 4503.554, 4503.561, 4503.562, 4503.564, 4503.576,	14
4503.591, 4503.67, 4503.68, 4503.69, 4503.701, 4503.71,	15
4503.711, 4503.712, 4503.713, 4503.72, 4503.73, 4503.732,	16

(B) The registrar shall pay the contributions the	19

registrar	collects	in	the	fund	as	follows:	20
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The registrar shall pay the contributions received 21 pursuant to section 4503.491 of the Revised Code to the breast 22 cancer fund of Ohio, which shall use that money only to pay for 23 programs that provide assistance and education to Ohio breast 24 cancer patients and that improve access for such patients to 25 quality health care and clinical trials and shall not use any of 26 the money for abortion information, counseling, services, or 27 other abortion-related activities. 28

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The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.492 of the Revised Code to the organization cancer support community central Ohio, which shall deposit the money into the Sheryl L. Kraner Fund of that organization. Cancer support community central Ohio shall expend the money it receives pursuant to this division only in the same manner and for the same purposes as that organization expends other money in that fund.

The registrar shall pay the contributions received 37 pursuant to section 4503.493 of the Revised Code to the autism 38 society of Ohio, which shall use the contributions for programs 39 and autism awareness efforts throughout the state. 40

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 41 receives pursuant to section 4503.494 of the Revised Code to the 42 national multiple sclerosis society for distribution in equal 43 amounts to the northwestern Ohio, Ohio buckeye, and Ohio valley 44 chapters of the national multiple sclerosis society. These 45 chapters shall use the money they receive under this section to 46 assist in paying the expenses they incur in providing services 47 directly to their clients. 48

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The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar	49
receives pursuant to section 4503.496 of the Revised Code to the	50
Ohio sickle cell and health association, which shall use the	51
contributions to help support educational, clinical, and social	52
support services for adults who have sickle cell disease.	53

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar

receives pursuant to section 4503.498 of the Revised Code to

special olympics Ohio, inc., which shall use the contributions

for its programs, charitable efforts, and other activities.

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The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar

receives pursuant to section 4503.499 of the Revised Code to the

children's glioma cancer foundation, which shall use the

contributions for its research and other programs.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.50 of the Revised Code to the future farmers of America foundation, which shall deposit the contributions into its general account to be used for educational and scholarship purposes of the future farmers of America foundation.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.501 of the Revised Code to the 4-H youth development program of the Ohio state university extension program, which shall use those contributions to pay the expenses it incurs in conducting its educational activities.

The registrar shall pay the contributions received 73
pursuant to section 4503.502 of the Revised Code to the Ohio 74
cattlemen's foundation, which shall use those contributions for 75
scholarships and other educational activities. 76

The registrar shall pay the contributions received

pursuant to section 4503.505 of the Revised Code to the	78
organization Ohio region phi theta kappa, which shall use those	79
contributions for scholarships for students who are members of	80
that organization.	81

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The registrar shall pay each contribution the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.51 of the Revised Code to the university or college whose name or marking or design appears on collegiate license plates that are issued to a person under that section. A university or college that receives contributions from the fund shall deposit the contributions into its general scholarship fund.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar

receives pursuant to section 4503.522 of the Revised Code to the

"friends of Perry's victory and international peace memorial,

incorporated," a nonprofit corporation organized under the laws

of this state, to assist that organization in paying the

expenses it incurs in sponsoring or holding charitable,

educational, and cultural events at the monument.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar

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receives pursuant to section 4503.523 of the Revised Code to the

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fairport lights foundation, which shall use the money to pay for

the restoration, maintenance, and preservation of the

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lighthouses of fairport harbor.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 101 receives pursuant to section 4503.524 of the Revised Code to the 102 Massillon tiger football booster club, which shall use the 103 contributions only to promote and support the football team of 104 Washington high school of the Massillon city school district. 105

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar

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The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.526 of the Revised Code to the Ohio district Kiwanis foundation of the Ohio district of Kiwanis international, which shall use the money it receives under this section to pay the costs of its educational and humanitarian activities.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar

receives pursuant to section 4503.531 of the Revised Code to the

thank you foundation, incorporated, a nonprofit corporation

organized under the laws of this state, to assist that

organization in paying for the charitable activities and

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 126 receives pursuant to section 4503.534 of the Revised Code to the 127 disabled American veterans department of Ohio, to be used for 128 programs that serve disabled American veterans and their 129 families. 130

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar

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receives pursuant to section 4503.55 of the Revised Code to the

pro football hall of fame, which shall deposit the contributions

into a special bank account that it establishes and which shall

be separate and distinct from any other account the pro football

hall of fame maintains, to be used exclusively for the purpose

source, including donations, gifts, and grants, that is	147

Ohio pet fund shall use the moneys it receives under this	149

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 171 receives pursuant to section 4503.554 of the Revised Code to the 172 Ohio state council of the knights of Columbus, which shall use 173 the contributions to pay for its charitable activities and 174 programs. 175

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 176 receives pursuant to section 4503.561 of the Revised Code to the 177 state of Ohio chapter of ducks unlimited, inc., which shall 178 deposit the contributions into a special bank account that it 179 establishes. The special bank account shall be separate and 180 distinct from any other account the state of Ohio chapter of 181 ducks unlimited, inc., maintains and shall be used exclusively 182 for the purpose of protecting, enhancing, restoring, and 183 managing wetlands and conserving wildlife habitat. The state of 184 Ohio chapter of ducks unlimited, inc., annually shall notify the 185 registrar in writing of the name, address, and account to which 186 such payments are to be made. 187

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar	197
receives pursuant to section 4503.576 of the Revised Code to the	198
Ohio state beekeepers association, which shall use those	199
contributions to promote beekeeping, provide educational	200
information about beekeeping, and to support other state and	201
local beekeeping programs.	202

The registrar shall pay to a sports commission created 203 pursuant to section 4503.591 of the Revised Code each 204 contribution the registrar receives under that section that an 205 206 applicant pays to obtain license plates that bear the logo of a professional sports team located in the county of that sports 207 commission and that is participating in the license plate 208 program pursuant to division (E) of that section, irrespective 209 of the county of residence of an applicant. 210

The registrar shall pay to a community charity each

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contribution the registrar receives under section 4503.591 of

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the Revised Code that an applicant pays to obtain license plates

pursuant to section 4503.712 of the Revised Code to Ohio	250
concerns of police survivors, which shall use those	251
contributions to provide whatever assistance may be appropriate	252
to the families of Ohio law enforcement officers who are killed	253
in the line of duty.	254
The registrar shall pay the contributions received	255

pursuant to section 4503.713 of the Revised Code to the greater	256
Cleveland peace officers memorial society, which shall use those	257
contributions to honor law enforcement officers who have died in	258
the line of duty and support its charitable purposes.	259

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 260 receives pursuant to section 4503.72 of the Revised Code to the 261 organization known on March 31, 2003, as the Ohio CASA/GAL 262 association, a private, nonprofit corporation organized under 263 Chapter 1702. of the Revised Code. The Ohio CASA/GAL association 264 265 shall use these contributions to pay the expenses it incurs in administering a program to secure the proper representation in 266 the courts of this state of abused, neglected, and dependent 267 children, and for the training and supervision of persons 268 participating in that program. 269

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 270 receives pursuant to section 4503.73 of the Revised Code to 271 Wright B. Flyer, incorporated, which shall deposit the 272 contributions into its general account to be used for purposes 273 of Wright B. Flyer, incorporated. 274

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 275 receives pursuant to section 4503.732 of the Revised Code to the 276 Siegel & Shuster society, a nonprofit organization dedicated to 277 commemorating and celebrating the creation of Superman in 278 Cleveland, Ohio. 279

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar

receives pursuant to section 4503.74 of the Revised Code to the

Columbus zoological park association, which shall disburse the

moneys to Ohio's major metropolitan zoos, as defined in section

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4503.74 of the Revised Code, in accordance with a written

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agreement entered into by the major metropolitan zoos.

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The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar	286
receives pursuant to section 4503.75 of the Revised Code to the	287
rotary foundation, located on March 31, 2003, in Evanston,	288
Illinois, to be placed in a fund known as the permanent fund and	289
used to endow educational and humanitarian programs of the	290
rotary foundation.	291
The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar	292
receives pursuant to section 4503.751 of the Revised Code to the	293
Ohio association of realtors, which shall deposit the	294
contributions into a property disaster relief fund maintained	295
under the Ohio realtors charitable and education foundation.	296
The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar	297
receives pursuant to section 4503.85 of the Revised Code to the	298
Ohio sea grant college program to be used for Lake Erie area	299
research projects.	300
The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar	301
receives pursuant to section 4503.86 of the Revised Code to the	302
Ohio Lincoln highway historic byway, which shall use those	303
contributions solely to promote and support the historical	304
preservation and advertisement of the Lincoln highway in this	305
state.	306
The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar	307
receives pursuant to section 4503.871 of the Revised Code to the	308
Solon city school district. The school district shall use the	309
contributions it receives to pay the expenses it incurs in	310
providing services to the school district's students that assist	311
in developing or maintaining the mental and emotional well-being	312
of the students. The services provided may include bereavement	313
counseling, instruction in defensive driving techniques,	314
sensitivity training, and the counseling and education of	315

students regarding bullying, dating violence, drug abuse,	316
suicide prevention, and human trafficking. The school district	317
superintendent or, in the school district superintendent's	318
discretion, the appropriate school principal or appropriate	319
school counselors shall determine any charitable organizations	320
that the school district hires to provide those services. The	321
school district also may use the contributions it receives to	322

City Schools" license plates shall bear county identification	381
stickers that identify the county of registration by name or	382
number.	383
(B) "Solon City Schools" license plates and validation	384
stickers shall be issued upon payment of the regular license tax	385
as prescribed under section 4503.04 of the Revised Code, any	386
applicable motor vehicle tax levied under Chapter 4504. of the	387
Revised Code, a bureau of motor vehicles administrative fee of	388
ten dollars, the contribution specified in division (C) of this	389
section, and compliance with all other applicable laws relating	390
to the registration of motor vehicles. If the application for	391
"Solon City Schools" license plates is combined with a request	392
for a special reserved license plate under section 4503.40 or	393
4503.42 of the Revised Code, the license plates and validation	394
sticker shall be issued upon payment of the contribution, fees,	395

renewal submitted under this section, the registrar shall	399
collect a contribution of thirty dollars. The registrar shall	400

The registrar shall pay the ten-dollar bureau	404
administrative fee, the purpose of which is to compensate the	405
bureau for additional services required in issuing "Solon City	406

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Schools" license plates, into the state treasury to the credit	407
of the state bureau of motor vehicles fund created in section	408
4501.25 of the Revised Code.	409
(D) Sections 4503.77 and 4503.78 of the Revised Code do	410
not apply to license plates issued under this section.	411
