A BILL

То	amend section 3503.14 and to enact section	1
	3503.20 of the Revised Code to require the	2
	Secretary of State to create an online voter	3
	registration system.	4

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 3503.14 be amended and section	5
3503.20 of the Revised Code be enacted to read as follows:	6
Sec. 3503.14. (A) The secretary of state shall prescribe	7
the form and content of the registration, change of residence,	8
and change of name forms used in this state. The forms shall	9
meet the requirements of the National Voter Registration Act of	10
1993 and shall include spaces for all of the following:	11
(1) The voter's name;	12
(2) The voter's address;	13
(3) The current date;	14
(4) The voter's date of birth;	15

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(5) The voter to provide one or more of the following:	16
(a) The voter's driver's license number, if any;	17
(b) The last four digits of the voter's social security	18
number, if any;	19
(c) A copy of a current and valid photo identification, a	20
copy of a military identification, or a copy of a current	21
utility bill, bank statement, government check, paycheck, or	22
other government document, other than a notice of voter	23
registration mailed by a board of elections under section	24
3503.19 of the Revised Code, that shows the voter's name and	25
address.	26
(6) The voter's signature.	27
The registration form shall include a space on which the	28
person registering an applicant shall sign the person's name and	29
provide the person's address and a space on which the person	30
registering an applicant shall name the employer who is	31
employing that person to register the applicant.	32
Except for forms prescribed by the secretary of state	33
under section 3503.11 of the Revised Code, the secretary of	34
state shall permit boards of elections to produce forms that	35
have subdivided spaces for each individual alphanumeric	36
character of the information provided by the voter so as to	37
accommodate the electronic reading and conversion of the voter's	38
information to data and the subsequent electronic transfer of	39
that data to the statewide voter registration database	40
established under section 3503.15 of the Revised Code.	41
(B) None of the following persons who are registering an	42
applicant in the course of that official's or employee's normal	43
duties shall sign the person's name, provide the person's	44

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address, or name the employer who is employing the person to	45
register an applicant on a form prepared under this section:	46
(1) An election official;	47
(2) A county treasurer;	48
(3) A deputy registrar of motor vehicles;	49
(4) An employee of a designated agency;	50
(5) An employee of a public high school;	51
(6) An employee of a public vocational school;	52
(7) An employee of a public library;	53
(8) An employee of the office of a county treasurer;	54
(9) An employee of the bureau of motor vehicles;	55
(10) An employee of a deputy registrar of motor vehicles;	56
(11) An employee of an election official.	57
(C) Except as provided in section 3501.382 of the Revised	58
Code, any applicant who is unable to sign the applicant's own	59
name shall make an "X," if possible, which shall be certified by	60
the signing of the name of the applicant by the person filling	61
out the form, who shall add the person's own signature. If an	62
applicant is unable to make an "X," the applicant shall indicate	63
in some manner that the applicant desires to register to vote or	64
to change the applicant's name or residence. The person	65
registering the applicant shall sign the form and attest that	66
the applicant indicated that the applicant desired to register	67
to vote or to change the applicant's name or residence.	68
(D) No registration, change of residence, or change of	69
name form shall be rejected solely on the basis that a person	70

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registering an applicant failed to sign the person's name or	71
failed to name the employer who is employing that person to	72
register the applicant as required under division (A) of this	73
section.	74
(E) A voter registration application submitted online	75
through the internet pursuant to section 3503.20 of the Revised	76
Code is not required to contain a signature to be considered	77
valid. The signature obtained under division (C)(1) of that	78
section shall be considered the applicant's signature for all	79
election and signature-matching purposes.	80
(F) As used in this section, "registering an applicant"	81
includes any effort, for compensation, to provide voter	82
registration forms or to assist persons in completing or	83
returning those forms.	84
Sec. 3503.20. (A) As used in this section, "applicant"	85
means an individual who is qualified to register to vote under	86
this chapter and who possesses a current and valid Ohio driver's	87
license or identification card issued under Chapter 4507. of the	88
Revised Code.	89
(B) The secretary of state, by rule, shall establish a	90
secure online process for voter registration. The rules shall	91
provide for an applicant to submit all of the following to the	92
<pre>secretary of state online through the internet:</pre>	93
(1) An application to register as a first-time voter in	94
Ohio or an application to change the applicant's name, address,	95
or both, as set forth in the applicant's existing voter	96
registration record;	97
(2) Information to establish that the applicant is	98
qualified to register to vote under this chapter;	99

(3) All of the following information:	100
(a) The applicant's name;	101
(b) The applicant's address;	102
(c) The applicant's date of birth;	103
(d) The last four digits of the applicant's social	104
<pre>security number;</pre>	105
(e) The number of the applicant's current and valid Ohio	106
driver's license or identification card issued under Chapter	107
4507. of the Revised Code.	108
(4) The applicant's attestation to the truth and accuracy	109
of the information submitted in the online application under	110
penalty of election falsification.	111
(C) The online voter registration application established	112
under division (B) of this section shall include the following	113
<pre>language:</pre>	114
"By clicking the box below, I affirm all of the following	115
under penalty of election falsification:	116
(1) I am the person whose name and identifying information	117
is provided on this form, and I desire to register to vote, or	118
update my voter registration, in the State of Ohio.	119
(2) All of the information I have provided on this form is	120
true and correct as of the date I am submitting this form.	121
(3) I authorize the Bureau of Motor Vehicles to transmit	122
to the Ohio Secretary of State my signature that is on file with	123
the Bureau of Motor Vehicles, and I understand and agree that	124
the signature transmitted by the Bureau of Motor Vehicles will	125
be used by the Secretary of State to validate this electronic	126

voter registration application as if I had signed this form	127
personally."	
In order to register to vote or update a voter	129
registration under division (B) of this section, an applicant or	130
elector shall be required to mark the box in the online voter	131
registration application that appears in conjunction with the	132
<pre>previous statement.</pre>	133
(D) When an applicant submits a voter registration	134
application under this section, the secretary of state shall	135
submit the completed application to the bureau of motor	136
vehicles. The bureau of motor vehicles shall compare the	137
information submitted by the applicant with the information	138
maintained in the bureau of motor vehicles database that lists	139
individuals who possess a current and valid Ohio driver's	140
license or identification card issued under Chapter 4507. of the	141
Revised Code.	142
(1) If the bureau of motor vehicles confirms that the	143
applicant possesses a current and valid Ohio driver's license or	144
identification card issued under Chapter 4507. of the Revised	145
Code, the bureau of motor vehicles shall submit the completed	146
application and the information compiled by the bureau of motor	147
vehicles, including an electronic copy of the applicant's	148
signature, to the secretary of state. The secretary of state	149
shall validate and submit the completed application and the	150
information compiled by the bureau of motor vehicles, including	151
the electronic signature of the applicant, to the board of	152
elections of the county in which the applicant resides. The	153
board of elections shall register the applicant. The electronic	154
signature shall be used as the applicant's signature on voter	155
registration records for all election and signature-matching	156

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purposes.	
(2) If the bureau of motor vehicles is unable to confirm	158
that the applicant possesses a current and valid Ohio driver's	159
license or identification card issued under Chapter 4507. of the	160
Revised Code, the bureau of motor vehicles shall submit the	161
completed application and the information that the bureau of	162
motor vehicles is unable to confirm that the applicant possesses	163
a current and valid Ohio driver's license or identification card	164
to the secretary of state. The secretary of state shall submit	165
the completed application and the information that the bureau of	166
motor vehicles is unable to confirm that the applicant possesses	167
a current and valid Ohio driver's license or identification card	168
to the board of elections of the county in which the applicant	169
resides. The board of elections shall send a notice to the	170
applicant that the application cannot be processed because the	171
bureau of motor vehicles cannot confirm that the applicant	172
possesses a current and valid Ohio driver's license or	173
identification card. The board of elections shall send the	174
notice to the applicant at the electronic mail address, if any,	175
provided in the application, and by mail to the address provided	176
in the application.	177
Section 2. That existing section 3503.14 of the Revised	178
Code is hereby repealed.	179
