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**A BILL**

To make supplemental appropriations to the Auditor 1  
of State for purposes of distributing these 2  
funds to political subdivisions in fiscal 3  
caution, watch, or emergency. 4

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:**

**Section 1.** All items in this section are hereby 5  
appropriated as designated out of any moneys in the state 6  
treasury to the credit of the designated fund. For all 7  
appropriations made in this act, those in the first column are 8  
for fiscal year 2016 and those in the second column are for 9  
fiscal year 2017. The appropriations made in this act are in 10  
addition to any other appropriations made for the FY 2016-FY 11  
2017 biennium. 12

On July 1, 2016, or as soon as possible thereafter, the 58  
Director of Budget and Management shall transfer \$25,860,726 in 59  
cash from the Budget Stabilization Fund to the Fiscal 60  
Watch/Emergency Fund (Fund 5SM0), which is hereby created. 61

**Section 2.** Within the limits set forth in this act, the 62  
Director of Budget and Management shall establish accounts 63  
indicating the source and amount of funds for each appropriation 64

made in this act, and shall determine the form and manner in 65  
which appropriation accounts shall be maintained. Expenditures 66  
from appropriations contained in this act shall be accounted for 67  
as though made in the main operating appropriations act of the 68  
131st General Assembly. 69

The appropriations made in this act are subject to all 70  
provisions of the main operating appropriations act of the 131st 71  
General Assembly that are generally applicable to such 72  
appropriations. 73
