A BILL

To make supplemental appropriations to the 1
Department of Transportation in order to provide 2
political subdivisions with funding for critical 3
road maintenance repairs. 4

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. All items in this section are hereby 5
appropriated as designated out of any moneys in the state 6
treasury to the credit of the designated fund. For all 7
appropriations made in this act, those in the first column are 8
for fiscal year 2016 and those in the second column are for 9
fiscal year 2017. The appropriations made in this act are in 10
addition to any other appropriations made for the FY 2016-FY 11
2017 biennium. 12

ROAD MAINTENANCE 18

The foregoing appropriation item 777627, Road Maintenance, 19
shall be used by the Director of Transportation to distribute 20
funding to political subdivisions for critical road maintenance 21
repairs. State funding that a political subdivision receives 22
under this appropriation item shall be distributed in a way so 23
that the state provides fifty per cent of the project funding. 24
The political subdivision will be responsible for the remaining 25
fifty per cent of the project funding. 26

On July 1, 2016, or as soon as possible thereafter, the 27
Director of Budget and Management shall transfer \$150 million in 28
cash from the Budget Stabilization Fund (Fund 7013) to the Road 29
Maintenance Fund (Fund 5ST0), which is hereby created. 30

Section 2. Within the limits set forth in this act, the 31
Director of Budget and Management shall establish accounts 32
indicating the source and amount of funds for each appropriation 33
made in this act, and shall determine the form and manner in 34
which appropriation accounts shall be maintained. Expenditures 35
from appropriations contained in this act shall be accounted for 36
as though made in the main operating appropriations act of the 37
131st General Assembly. 38

The appropriations made in this act are subject to all 39
provisions of the main operating appropriations act of the 131st 40
General Assembly that are generally applicable to such 41
appropriations. 42
