A C O N C U R R E N T R E S O L U T I O N

To delegate to the President of the Senate and the	1
Speaker of the House of Representatives	2
authority to designate groups of members to	3
prepare arguments for and against amendments to	4
the Ohio Constitution proposed by the General	5
Assembly, a person or persons to prepare an	6
argument for any law, section, or item submitted	7
to the electors by referendum petition, and a	8
person or persons to prepare an argument against	9
any constitutional amendment proposed by	10
initiative petition.	11

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF THE STATE OF OHIO (THE SENATE
CONCURRING):**

WHEREAS, When the General Assembly adopts a joint	12
resolution proposing an amendment to the Ohio Constitution	13
under Ohio Constitution, Article XVI, Section 1, it may	14
designate, under section 3505.063 of the Revised Code, a group	15
of members who voted in support of the joint resolution to	16
prepare arguments for the proposed amendment and, unless no	17
members voted in opposition, a group of members who voted in	18
opposition to the joint resolution to prepare arguments against	19
the proposed amendment; and	20

WHEREAS, The General Assembly, if in session, is required	21
to name the person or persons who will prepare the argument,	22

explanation, or both, for any law, section, or item submitted 23
to the electors by referendum petition, under Ohio 24
Constitution, Article II, Section 1g; now therefore be it 25

RESOLVED, That, when the 130th and 131st General Assemblies 26
adopt a joint resolution proposing an amendment to the Ohio 27
Constitution, the President of the Senate and the Speaker of 28
the House of Representatives, on behalf of the 131st General 29
Assembly, may designate a group of members who voted in support 30
of the joint resolution to prepare arguments for the proposed 31
amendment and, unless no members voted in opposition, a group 32
of members who voted in opposition to the joint resolution to 33
prepare arguments against the proposed amendment; and be it 34
further 35

RESOLVED, That the President of the Senate and the Speaker 36
of the House of Representatives, on behalf of the 131st General 37
Assembly, may designate the person or persons who will prepare 38
the argument, explanation, or both, for any law, section, or 39
item submitted to the electors by referendum petition during 40
the 131st General Assembly; and be it further 41

RESOLVED, That the President of the Senate and the Speaker 42
of the House of Representatives, on behalf of the 131st General 43
Assembly, may designate the person or persons who will prepare 44
the argument against any constitutional amendment proposed by 45
initiative petition during the 131st General Assembly; and be 46
it further 47

RESOLVED, That the President of the Senate and the Speaker 48
of the House of Representatives make their designations so as 49
to leave the designated group or groups of members, person, or 50
persons with sufficient time to prepare and file their 51
arguments with the Secretary of State not later than the 52
eightieth day before the day of the election at which the issue 53
will be submitted to the electors. 54
