RESOLVED, That the President of the Senate and the Speaker of 39 the House of Representatives, on behalf of the 131st General 40 Assembly, may designate the person or persons who will prepare the 41 argument against any constitutional amendment proposed by 42 initiative petition during the 131st General Assembly; and be it 43 further 44

RESOLVED, That the President of the Senate and the Speaker of 45 the House of Representatives make their designations so as to 46 leave the designated group or groups of members, person, or 47 persons with sufficient time to prepare and file their arguments 48 with the Secretary of State not later than the eightieth day 49 before the day of the election at which the issue will be 50 submitted to the electors. 51
