A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

To urge the Secretary of the Navy to name a guided	1
missile destroyer vessel the O.H. Perry, in honor of	2
Commodore Perry who fought in the Battle of Lake Erie	3
during the War of 1812.	4

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF OHIO (THE SENATE CONCURRING):

WHEREAS, The War of 1812 occurred between the United States	5
of America and Great Britain from 1812 to 1815; and	6
WHEREAS, Commodore Oliver Hazard Perry fought bravely	7
during the War of 1812 at the Battle of Lake Erie; and	8
WHEREAS, Northwest Ohio, with its access to the Great	9
Lakes, to Fort Detroit, and to Canada, served a particularly	10
significant role during the war; and	11
WHEREAS, In the Battle of Lake Erie, which took place on	12
September 10, 1813, American sailors under the command of	13
Commodore Perry defeated the British Lake Erie squadron near the	14
Bass Islands; and	15
WHEREAS, America's victory in the Battle of Lake Erie was a	16
direct result of the extraordinary bravery of Commodore Perry	17

and the men who served under him; and 18 WHEREAS, The United States Navy is currently constructing 19 Arleigh Burke Class Destroyers, a class of guided missile 20 destroyer vessels; and 21 WHEREAS, The guided missile destroyer vessels are named for 22 distinguished United States Navy and Marine Corps officers and 23 enlisted men by the Secretary of the Navy; now therefore be it 24 RESOLVED, That we, the members of the 131st General 25 Assembly of the State of Ohio, urge the Secretary of the Navy to 26 name a Navy Burke Class Destroyer the O.H. Perry, in honor of 27 Commodore Perry; and be it further 28 RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the House of Representatives 29 transmit duly authenticated copies of this resolution to the 30 Secretary of the Navy and the news media of Ohio. 31
