A JOINT RESOLUTION

or involuntary servitude in Ohio for the punishment of	
crime.	

Be it resolved by the General Assembly of the State of	5
Ohio, three-fifths of the members elected to each house	6
concurring herein, that there shall be submitted to the electors	7
of the state, in the manner prescribed by law at the general	8
election to be held on November 8, 2016, a proposal to amend	9
Section 6 of Article I of the Constitution of the State of Ohio	10
to read as follows:	11

ARTICLE I	12
Section 6. There shall be no slavery in this state; nor	13
involuntary servitude, unless for the punishment of crime.	14
EFFECTIVE DATE AND REPEAL	15
If adopted by a majority of the electors voting on this	16
amendment, the amendment shall take effect immediately, and	17
existing Section 6 of Article I of the Constitution of the State	18

of Ohio shall be repealed from such effective date.
