**A RESOLUTION**

Relative to the election of Kristin Boggs to fill the 1  
vacancy in the membership of the House of 2  
Representatives created by the resignation of Michael 3  
Stinziano of the 18th House District. 4

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF  
OHIO:**

WHEREAS, Section 11 of Article II of the Ohio Constitution 5  
provides for the filling of a vacancy in the membership of the 6  
House of Representatives by election by the members of the House 7  
of Representatives who are affiliated with the same political 8  
party as the person last elected to the seat which has become 9  
vacant; and 10

WHEREAS, Michael Stinziano of the 18th House District, has 11  
resigned as a member of the House of Representatives of the 131st 12  
General Assembly effective December 31, 2015, thus creating a 13  
vacancy in the House of Representatives; therefore be it 14

RESOLVED, By the members of the House of Representatives 15  
who are affiliated with the Democrat party that Kristin Boggs, 16  
Democrat, having the qualifications set forth in the Ohio 17  
Constitution and the laws of Ohio to be a member of the House of 18  
Representatives from the 18th House District, is hereby elected, 19  
effective January 26, 2016, pursuant to Section 11 of Article II 20  
of the Ohio Constitution, as a member of the House of 21  
Representatives from the 18th House District, to fill the vacancy 22  
created by the unexpired portion of the term of said Michael 23  
Stinziano, ending on December 31, 2016; and be it further 24

RESOLVED, That a copy of this resolution be spread upon	25
the pages of the Journal of the House of Representatives together	26
with the yeas and nays of the members of the House of	27
Representatives affiliated with the Democrat party voting on the	28
resolution, and that the Clerk of the House of Representatives	29
shall certify the resolution and vote on its adoption to the	30
Secretary of State.	31
