BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 3701.034 of the Revised Code be	8
enacted to read as follows:	9
Sec. 3701.034. (A) As used in this section:	10

entity a legal relationship created or governed by at least one	12
written instrument that demonstrates any of the following:	
(a) Common ownership, management, or control;	14
