BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 5902.10 of the Revised Code be	9
enacted to read as follows:	10
Sec. 5902.10. (A) As used in this section:	11
(1) "Public transportation" means publicly owned or	12
operated transportation by bus, rail, or other conveyance, that	13
provides to the public transit or paratransit service on a	14
regular and continuing basis within the state, including demand-	15
responsive transportation.	
(2) "Veteran" means either of the following:	17

(a) A person who served in the armed forces of the United	18
States on active military duty and was discharged from the	19
service under honorable conditions, and who either served on	20
active duty for reasons other than training or, while serving on	21
active duty for training, incurred a disability recognized by	22
the department of veterans affairs or department of defense as	23
service-connected;	24
(b) A person who served in the United States merchant	25
marine, who either served on active duty for reasons other than	26
training or, while serving on active duty for training, incurred	27
a disability recognized by the department of veterans affairs or	28
department of defense as service-connected, and to whom either	29
of the following applies:	30
(i) The person has an honorable report of separation from	31
the active duty military service, form DD214 or DD215;	32
(ii) The person served in the United States merchant	33
marine between December 7, 1941, and December 31, 1946.	34
(B) The director of veterans services shall issue a	35
military transportation card to a person if both of the	36
following apply:	37
(1) The person submits a written application indicating	38
that the person is a veteran or an active duty member of any	39
branch of the armed forces of the United States; and	40
(2) The person submits to the director such documentary	41
evidence that the director prescribes by rule that is sufficient	42
to prove to the director that the person is a veteran or an	43
active duty member of a branch of the armed forces of the United	44
<u>States.</u>	45
The military transportation card entitles the person, upon	46

presentation, to board any mode of public transportation and	47
travel on the public transportation without payment of any fee,	
fare, or charge of any kind. The director shall issue a military	49
transportation card at no cost to the person to whom it is	50
issued.	
(C) A military transportation card issued to a person who	52
(c) A military transportation card issued to a person who	52
is a veteran does not expire. A military transportation card	
issued to a person who is an active duty member of a branch of	
the armed forces of the United States expires on the date the	
person is scheduled to cease to be such a member as shown in the	56
documentary evidence the person submits to the director at the	
time of application.	
(D) The director, under Chapter 119. of the Revised Code,	59
shall adopt such rules as the director determines are necessary	
to implement this section.
