BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 2901.33 of the Revised Code be	5
enacted to read as follows:	6
Sec. 2901.33. (A) As used in this section, "owners	7
association" and "planned community" have the same meanings as	8
in section 5312.01 of the Revised Code.	9
(B) An owners association of a planned community, a	10
neighborhood association, a neighborhood watch, or a similarly	11
organized residential entity that is recognized by state or	12
local law with defined boundaries referenced in the residential	13
entity's charter or governing document may seek an injunction or	14
restraining order prohibiting an offender from entering the	15
boundaries of the residential area, if both of the following	16
apply:	17
(1) The offender has pleaded quilty to or been convicted	18

of three or more separate violations of any one or any	19
combination of sections 2903.01, 2903.02, 2903.03, 2903.04,	20
2903.041, 2903.05, 2903.06, 2907.02, 2907.03, 2907.04, 2907.05,	21
2907.06, 2907.21, 2907.22, 2907.23, 2907.24, 2907.25, 2909.05,	22

(2) Three or more of the offenses were committed within the boundaries of the residential area.	28 29
(C) Any injunction or restraining order shall remain in	30
effect for one year, unless modified or dissolved by the court	
that granted the injunction or restraining order, and may be	32
renewed by the court upon motion of the owners association,	
neighborhood association, neighborhood watch, or similarly	
organized residential entity.	
(D) This section shall be known as the "neighborhood	36
protection act."
