**A BILL**

To amend section 4501.21 and to enact section 1  
4503.733 of the Revised Code to create the 2  
"Buckeye Corvette" license plate. 3

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:**

**Section 1.** That section 4501.21 be amended and section 4  
4503.733 of the Revised Code be enacted to read as follows: 5

**Sec. 4501.21.** (A) There is hereby created in the state 6  
treasury the license plate contribution fund. The fund shall 7  
consist of all contributions paid by motor vehicle registrants 8  
and collected by the registrar of motor vehicles pursuant to 9  
sections 4503.491, 4503.492, 4503.493, 4503.494, 4503.495, 10  
4503.496, 4503.498, 4503.499, 4503.50, 4503.501, 4503.502, 11  
4503.505, 4503.51, 4503.522, 4503.523, 4503.524, 4503.525, 12  
4503.526, 4503.528, 4503.529, 4503.531, 4503.534, 4503.545, 13  
4503.55, 4503.551, 4503.552, 4503.553, 4503.554, 4503.555, 14  
4503.561, 4503.562, 4503.564, 4503.565, 4503.576, 4503.577, 15  
4503.591, 4503.592, 4503.67, 4503.68, 4503.69, 4503.701, 16  
4503.71, 4503.711, 4503.712, 4503.713, 4503.715, 4503.72, 17  
4503.73, 4503.732, 4503.733, 4503.74, 4503.75, 4503.751, 18  
4503.763, 4503.85, 4503.86, 4503.87, 4503.89, 4503.90, 4503.902, 19

4503.903, 4503.904, 4503.92, 4503.94, and 4503.97 of the Revised Code. 20

(B) The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar collects in the fund as follows: 22  
23

The registrar shall pay the contributions received pursuant to section 4503.491 of the Revised Code to the breast cancer fund of Ohio, which shall use that money only to pay for programs that provide assistance and education to Ohio breast cancer patients and that improve access for such patients to quality health care and clinical trials and shall not use any of the money for abortion information, counseling, services, or other abortion-related activities. 24

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.492 of the Revised Code to the organization cancer support community central Ohio, which shall deposit the money into the Sheryl L. Kraner Fund of that organization. Cancer support community central Ohio shall expend the money it receives pursuant to this division only in the same manner and for the same purposes as that organization expends other money in that fund. 32

The registrar shall pay the contributions received pursuant to section 4503.493 of the Revised Code to the autism society of Ohio, which shall use the contributions for programs and autism awareness efforts throughout the state. 40

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.494 of the Revised Code to the national multiple sclerosis society for distribution in equal amounts to the northwestern Ohio, Ohio buckeye, and Ohio valley chapters of the national multiple sclerosis society. These 44

chapters shall use the money they receive under this section to 49  
assist in paying the expenses they incur in providing services 50  
directly to their clients. 51

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 52  
receives pursuant to section 4503.495 of the Revised Code to the 53  
national pancreatic cancer foundation, which shall use the money 54  
it receives under this section to assist those who suffer with 55  
pancreatic cancer and their families. 56

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 57  
receives pursuant to section 4503.496 of the Revised Code to the 58  
Ohio sickle cell and health association, which shall use the 59  
contributions to help support educational, clinical, and social 60  
support services for adults who have sickle cell disease. 61

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 62  
receives pursuant to section 4503.498 of the Revised Code to 63  
special olympics Ohio, inc., which shall use the contributions 64  
for its programs, charitable efforts, and other activities. 65

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 66  
receives pursuant to section 4503.499 of the Revised Code to the 67  
children's glioma cancer foundation, which shall use the 68  
contributions for its research and other programs. 69

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 70  
receives pursuant to section 4503.50 of the Revised Code to the 71  
future farmers of America foundation, which shall deposit the 72  
contributions into its general account to be used for 73  
educational and scholarship purposes of the future farmers of 74  
America foundation. 75

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 76  
receives pursuant to section 4503.501 of the Revised Code to the 77

4-H youth development program of the Ohio state university 78  
extension program, which shall use those contributions to pay 79  
the expenses it incurs in conducting its educational activities. 80

The registrar shall pay the contributions received 81  
pursuant to section 4503.502 of the Revised Code to the Ohio 82  
cattlemen's foundation, which shall use those contributions for 83  
scholarships and other educational activities. 84

The registrar shall pay the contributions received 85  
pursuant to section 4503.505 of the Revised Code to the 86  
organization Ohio region phi theta kappa, which shall use those 87  
contributions for scholarships for students who are members of 88  
that organization. 89

The registrar shall pay each contribution the registrar 90  
receives pursuant to section 4503.51 of the Revised Code to the 91  
university or college whose name or marking or design appears on 92  
collegiate license plates that are issued to a person under that 93  
section. A university or college that receives contributions 94  
from the fund shall deposit the contributions into its general 95  
scholarship fund. 96

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 97  
receives pursuant to section 4503.522 of the Revised Code to the 98  
"friends of Perry's victory and international peace memorial, 99  
incorporated," a nonprofit corporation organized under the laws 100  
of this state, to assist that organization in paying the 101  
expenses it incurs in sponsoring or holding charitable, 102  
educational, and cultural events at the monument. 103

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 104  
receives pursuant to section 4503.523 of the Revised Code to the 105  
fairport lights foundation, which shall use the money to pay for 106

the restoration, maintenance, and preservation of the 107  
lighthouses of fairport harbor. 108

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 109  
receives pursuant to section 4503.524 of the Revised Code to the 110  
Massillon tiger football booster club, which shall use the 111  
contributions only to promote and support the football team of 112  
Washington high school of the Massillon city school district. 113

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 114  
receives pursuant to section 4503.525 of the Revised Code to the 115  
United States power squadron districts seven, eleven, twenty- 116  
four, and twenty-nine in equal amounts. Each power squadron 117  
district shall use the money it receives under this section to 118  
pay for the educational boating programs each district holds or 119  
sponsors within this state. 120

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 121  
receives pursuant to section 4503.526 of the Revised Code to the 122  
Ohio district Kiwanis foundation of the Ohio district of Kiwanis 123  
international, which shall use the money it receives under this 124  
section to pay the costs of its educational and humanitarian 125  
activities. 126

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 127  
receives pursuant to section 4503.528 of the Revised Code to the 128  
Ohio association of child caring agencies, which shall use the 129  
money it receives under this section to pay the expenses it 130  
incurs in advancing its mission of sustainably improving the 131  
provision of services to children, young adults, and families in 132  
this state. 133

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 134  
receives pursuant to section 4503.529 of the Revised Code to the 135

Ohio nurses foundation. The foundation shall use the money it 136  
receives under this section to provide educational scholarships 137  
to assist individuals who aspire to join the nursing profession, 138  
to assist nurses in the nursing profession who seek to advance 139  
their education, and to support persons conducting nursing 140  
research concerning the evidence-based practice of nursing and 141  
the improvement of patient outcomes. 142

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 143  
receives pursuant to section 4503.531 of the Revised Code to the 144  
thank you foundation, incorporated, a nonprofit corporation 145  
organized under the laws of this state, to assist that 146  
organization in paying for the charitable activities and 147  
programs it sponsors in support of United States military 148  
personnel, veterans, and their families. 149

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 150  
receives pursuant to section 4503.534 of the Revised Code to the 151  
disabled American veterans department of Ohio, to be used for 152  
programs that serve disabled American veterans and their 153  
families. 154

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 155  
receives pursuant to section 4503.55 of the Revised Code to the 156  
pro football hall of fame, which shall deposit the contributions 157  
into a special bank account that it establishes and which shall 158  
be separate and distinct from any other account the pro football 159  
hall of fame maintains, to be used exclusively for the purpose 160  
of promoting the pro football hall of fame as a travel 161  
destination. 162

The registrar shall pay the contributions that are paid to 163  
the registrar pursuant to section 4503.545 of the Revised Code 164  
to the national rifle association foundation, which shall use 165

the money to pay the costs of the educational activities and 166  
programs the foundation holds or sponsors in this state. 167

The registrar shall pay to the Ohio pet fund the 168  
contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 169  
4503.551 of the Revised Code and any other money from any other 170  
source, including donations, gifts, and grants, that is 171  
designated by the source to be paid to the Ohio pet fund. The 172  
Ohio pet fund shall use the moneys it receives under this 173  
section to support programs for the sterilization of dogs and 174  
cats and for educational programs concerning the proper 175  
veterinary care of those animals, and for expenses of the Ohio 176  
pet fund that are reasonably necessary for it to obtain and 177  
maintain its tax-exempt status and to perform its duties. 178

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 179  
receives pursuant to section 4503.552 of the Revised Code to the 180  
rock and roll hall of fame and museum, incorporated. 181

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 182  
receives pursuant to section 4503.553 of the Revised Code to the 183  
Ohio coalition for animals, incorporated, a nonprofit 184  
corporation. Except as provided in division (B) of this section, 185  
the coalition shall distribute the money to its members, and the 186  
members shall use the money only to pay for educational, 187  
charitable, and other programs of each coalition member that 188  
provide care for unwanted, abused, and neglected horses. The 189  
Ohio coalition for animals may use a portion of the money to pay 190  
for reasonable marketing costs incurred in the design and 191  
promotion of the license plate and for administrative costs 192  
incurred in the disbursement and management of funds received 193  
under this section. 194

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 195

receives pursuant to section 4503.554 of the Revised Code to the 196  
Ohio state council of the knights of Columbus, which shall use 197  
the contributions to pay for its charitable activities and 198  
programs. 199

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 200  
receives pursuant to section 4503.555 of the Revised Code to the 201  
western reserve historical society, which shall use the 202  
contributions to fund the Crawford auto aviation museum. 203

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 204  
receives pursuant to section 4503.561 of the Revised Code to the 205  
state of Ohio chapter of ducks unlimited, inc., which shall 206  
deposit the contributions into a special bank account that it 207  
establishes. The special bank account shall be separate and 208  
distinct from any other account the state of Ohio chapter of 209  
ducks unlimited, inc., maintains and shall be used exclusively 210  
for the purpose of protecting, enhancing, restoring, and 211  
managing wetlands and conserving wildlife habitat. The state of 212  
Ohio chapter of ducks unlimited, inc., annually shall notify the 213  
registrar in writing of the name, address, and account to which 214  
such payments are to be made. 215

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 216  
receives pursuant to section 4503.562 of the Revised Code to the 217  
Mahoning river consortium, which shall use the money to pay the 218  
expenses it incurs in restoring and maintaining the Mahoning 219  
river watershed. 220

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 221  
receives pursuant to section 4503.564 of the Revised Code to 222  
Antioch college for the use of the Glen Helen ecology institute 223  
to pay expenses related to the Glen Helen nature preserve. 224

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.565 of the Revised Code to the conservancy for Cuyahoga valley national park, which shall use the money in support of the park.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.576 of the Revised Code to the Ohio state beekeepers association, which shall use those contributions to promote beekeeping, provide educational information about beekeeping, and to support other state and local beekeeping programs.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.577 of the Revised Code to the national aviation hall of fame, which shall use the contributions to fulfill its mission of honoring aerospace legends to inspire future leaders.

The registrar shall pay to a sports commission created pursuant to section 4503.591 of the Revised Code each contribution the registrar receives under that section that an applicant pays to obtain license plates that bear the logo of a professional sports team located in the county of that sports commission and that is participating in the license plate program pursuant to division (E) of that section, irrespective of the county of residence of an applicant.

The registrar shall pay to a community charity each contribution the registrar receives under section 4503.591 of the Revised Code that an applicant pays to obtain license plates that bear the logo of a professional sports team that is participating in the license plate program pursuant to division (G) of that section.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.592 of the Revised Code to monarch wings across Ohio, which shall use the contributions for the protection and preservation of the monarch butterfly and pollinator corridor in Ohio and for educational programs.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.67 of the Revised Code to the Dan Beard council of the boy scouts of America. The council shall distribute all contributions in an equitable manner throughout the state to regional councils of the boy scouts.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.68 of the Revised Code to the great river council of the girl scouts of the United States of America. The council shall distribute all contributions in an equitable manner throughout the state to regional councils of the girl scouts.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.69 of the Revised Code to the Dan Beard council of the boy scouts of America. The council shall distribute all contributions in an equitable manner throughout the state to regional councils of the boy scouts.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.701 of the Revised Code to the Prince Hall grand lodge of free and accepted masons of Ohio, which shall use the contributions for scholarship purposes.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.71 of the Revised Code to the fraternal order of police of Ohio, incorporated, which shall deposit the fees into its general account to be used for

purposes of the fraternal order of police of Ohio, incorporated. 283

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 284  
receives pursuant to section 4503.711 of the Revised Code to the 285  
fraternal order of police of Ohio, incorporated, which shall 286  
deposit the contributions into an account that it creates to be 287  
used for the purpose of advancing and protecting the law 288  
enforcement profession, promoting improved law enforcement 289  
methods, and teaching respect for law and order. 290

The registrar shall pay the contributions received 291  
pursuant to section 4503.712 of the Revised Code to Ohio 292  
concerns of police survivors, which shall use those 293  
contributions to provide whatever assistance may be appropriate 294  
to the families of Ohio law enforcement officers who are killed 295  
in the line of duty. 296

The registrar shall pay the contributions received 297  
pursuant to section 4503.713 of the Revised Code to the greater 298  
Cleveland peace officers memorial society, which shall use those 299  
contributions to honor law enforcement officers who have died in 300  
the line of duty and support its charitable purposes. 301

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 302  
receives pursuant to section 4503.715 of the Revised Code to the 303  
fallen linemen organization, which shall use the contributions 304  
to recognize and memorialize fallen linemen and support their 305  
families. 306

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 307  
receives pursuant to section 4503.72 of the Revised Code to the 308  
organization known on March 31, 2003, as the Ohio CASA/GAL 309  
association, a private, nonprofit corporation organized under 310  
Chapter 1702. of the Revised Code. The Ohio CASA/GAL association 311

shall use these contributions to pay the expenses it incurs in 312  
administering a program to secure the proper representation in 313  
the courts of this state of abused, neglected, and dependent 314  
children, and for the training and supervision of persons 315  
participating in that program. 316

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 317  
receives pursuant to section 4503.73 of the Revised Code to 318  
Wright B. Flyer, incorporated, which shall deposit the 319  
contributions into its general account to be used for purposes 320  
of Wright B. Flyer, incorporated. 321

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 322  
receives pursuant to section 4503.732 of the Revised Code to the 323  
Siegel & Shuster society, a nonprofit organization dedicated to 324  
commemorating and celebrating the creation of Superman in 325  
Cleveland, Ohio. 326

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 327  
receives pursuant to section 4503.733 of the Revised Code to 328  
buckeye corvettes, incorporated, which shall use the 329  
contributions to pay for its charitable activities and programs. 330

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 331  
receives pursuant to section 4503.74 of the Revised Code to the 332  
Columbus zoological park association, which shall disburse the 333  
moneys to Ohio's major metropolitan zoos, as defined in section 334  
4503.74 of the Revised Code, in accordance with a written 335  
agreement entered into by the major metropolitan zoos. 336

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 337  
receives pursuant to section 4503.75 of the Revised Code to the 338  
rotary foundation, located on March 31, 2003, in Evanston, 339  
Illinois, to be placed in a fund known as the permanent fund and 340

used to endow educational and humanitarian programs of the 341  
rotary foundation. 342

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 343  
receives pursuant to section 4503.751 of the Revised Code to the 344  
Ohio association of realtors, which shall deposit the 345  
contributions into a property disaster relief fund maintained 346  
under the Ohio realtors charitable and education foundation. 347

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 348  
receives pursuant to section 4503.763 of the Revised Code to the 349  
Ohio history connection to be used solely to build, support, and 350  
maintain the Ohio battleflag collection within the Ohio history 351  
connection. 352

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 353  
receives pursuant to section 4503.85 of the Revised Code to the 354  
Ohio sea grant college program to be used for Lake Erie area 355  
research projects. 356

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 357  
receives pursuant to section 4503.86 of the Revised Code to the 358  
Ohio Lincoln highway historic byway, which shall use those 359  
contributions solely to promote and support the historical 360  
preservation and advertisement of the Lincoln highway in this 361  
state. 362

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 363  
receives pursuant to section 4503.87 of the Revised Code to the 364  
Grove City little league dream field fund, which shall use those 365  
contributions solely to build, maintain, and improve youth 366  
baseball fields within the municipal corporation of Grove City. 367

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 368  
receives pursuant to section 4503.89 of the Revised Code to the 369

American red cross of greater Columbus on behalf of the Ohio 370  
chapters of the American red cross, which shall use the 371  
contributions for disaster readiness, preparedness, and response 372  
programs on a statewide basis. 373

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 374  
receives pursuant to section 4503.90 of the Revised Code to the 375  
nationwide children's hospital foundation. 376

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 377  
receives pursuant to section 4503.902 of the Revised Code to St. 378  
Ignatius high school located in the municipal corporation of 379  
Cleveland. The school shall use fifty per cent of the 380  
contributions it receives to provide tuition assistance to its 381  
students. The school shall use the remaining fifty per cent to 382  
pay the expenses it incurs in providing services to the school's 383  
students that assist in developing or maintaining the mental and 384  
emotional well-being of the students. The services provided may 385  
include bereavement counseling, instruction in defensive driving 386  
techniques, sensitivity training, and the counseling and 387  
education of students regarding bullying, dating violence, drug 388  
abuse, suicide prevention, and human trafficking. As a part of 389  
providing such services, the school may pay for members of the 390  
faculty of the school to receive training in providing those 391  
services. The school principal or, in the school principal's 392  
discretion, appropriate school counselors shall determine any 393  
charitable organizations that the school hires to provide those 394  
services. The school shall ensure that any such charitable 395  
organization is exempt from federal income taxation under 396  
subsection 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. The school 397  
shall not use the contributions it receives for any other 398  
purpose. 399

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.903 of the Revised Code to the Brecksville-Broadview Heights city school district. The school district shall use the contributions it receives to pay the expenses it incurs in providing services to the school district's students that assist in developing or maintaining the mental and emotional well-being of the students. The services provided may include bereavement counseling, instruction in defensive driving techniques, sensitivity training, and the counseling and education of students regarding bullying, dating violence, drug abuse, suicide prevention, and human trafficking. The school district superintendent or, in the school district superintendent's discretion, the appropriate school principal or appropriate school counselors shall determine any charitable organizations that the school district hires to provide those services. The school district also may use the contributions it receives to pay for members of the faculty of the school district to receive training in providing such services to the students of the school district. The school district shall ensure that any charitable organization that is hired by the district is exempt from federal income taxation under subsection 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. The school district shall not use the contributions it receives for any other purpose.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.904 of the Revised Code to the Chagrin Falls exempted village school district. The school district shall use the contributions it receives to pay the expenses it incurs in providing services to the school district's students that assist in developing or maintaining the mental and emotional well-being of the students. The services

provided may include bereavement counseling, instruction in 431  
defensive driving techniques, sensitivity training, and the 432  
counseling and education of students regarding bullying, dating 433  
violence, drug abuse, suicide prevention, and human trafficking. 434  
The school district superintendent or, in the school district 435  
superintendent's discretion, the appropriate school principal or 436  
appropriate school counselors shall determine any charitable 437  
organizations that the school district hires to provide those 438  
services. The school district also may use the contributions it 439  
receives to pay for members of the faculty of the school 440  
district to receive training in providing such services to the 441  
students of the school district. The school district shall 442  
ensure that any charitable organization that is hired by the 443  
district is exempt from federal income taxation under subsection 444  
501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. The school district 445  
shall not use the contributions it receives for any other 446  
purpose. 447

The registrar shall pay the contributions received 448  
pursuant to section 4503.92 of the Revised Code to support our 449  
troops, incorporated, a national nonprofit corporation, which 450  
shall use those contributions in accordance with its articles of 451  
incorporation and for the benefit of servicemembers of the armed 452  
forces of the United States and their families when they are in 453  
financial need. 454

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 455  
receives pursuant to section 4503.94 of the Revised Code to the 456  
Michelle's leading star foundation, which shall use the money 457  
solely to fund the rental, lease, or purchase of the simulated 458  
driving curriculum of the Michelle's leading star foundation by 459  
boards of education of city, exempted village, local, and joint 460  
vocational school districts. 461

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.97 of the Revised Code to the friends of united Hatzalah of Israel, which shall use the money to support united Hatzalah of Israel, which provides free emergency medical first response throughout Israel.

(C) All investment earnings of the license plate contribution fund shall be credited to the fund. Not later than the first day of May of every year, the registrar shall distribute to each entity described in division (B) of this section the investment income the fund earned the previous calendar year. The amount of such a distribution paid to an entity shall be proportionate to the amount of money the entity received from the fund during the previous calendar year.

Sec. 4503.733. (A) The owner or lessee of any passenger car, noncommercial motor vehicle, recreational vehicle, or other vehicle of a class approved by the registrar of motor vehicles may apply to the registrar for the registration of the vehicle and issuance of "buckeye corvette" license plates. An application made under this section may be combined with a request for a special reserved license plate under section 4503.40 or 4503.42 of the Revised Code. Upon receipt of the completed application and compliance by the applicant with divisions (B) and (C) of this section, the registrar shall issue to the applicant the appropriate vehicle registration and a set of "buckeye corvette" license plates and a validation sticker, or a validation sticker alone when required by section 4503.191 of the Revised Code.

In addition to the letters and numbers ordinarily inscribed on the license plates, "buckeye corvette" license plates shall be inscribed with identifying words or markings

that are designed by buckeye corvettes, incorporated and that 492  
are approved by the registrar. "Buckeye corvette" license plates 493  
shall display county identification stickers that identify the 494  
county of registration as required under section 4503.19 of the 495  
Revised Code. 496

(B) "Buckeye corvette" license plates and a validation 497  
sticker, or validation sticker alone, shall be issued upon 498  
receipt of a contribution as provided in division (C) (1) of this 499  
section and upon payment of the regular license tax as 500  
prescribed under section 4503.04 of the Revised Code, any 501  
applicable motor vehicle license tax levied under Chapter 4504. 502  
of the Revised Code, any applicable additional fee prescribed by 503  
section 4503.40 or 4503.42 of the Revised Code, a bureau of 504  
motor vehicles administrative fee of ten dollars, and compliance 505  
with all other applicable laws relating to the registration of 506  
motor vehicles. 507

(C) (1) For each application for registration and 508  
registration renewal notice the registrar receives under this 509  
section, the registrar shall collect a contribution of twenty 510  
dollars. The registrar shall transmit this contribution into the 511  
state treasury to the credit of the license plate contribution 512  
fund created in section 4501.21 of the Revised Code. 513

(2) The registrar shall deposit the bureau administrative 514  
fee of ten dollars, the purpose of which is to compensate the 515  
bureau for additional services required in the issuing of 516  
"buckeye corvette" license plates, into the state treasury to 517  
the credit of the state bureau of motor vehicles fund created in 518  
section 4501.25 of the Revised Code. 519

**Section 2.** That existing section 4501.21 of the Revised 520  
Code is hereby repealed. 521
