In memory of D. Michael Collins.

WHEREAS, Michael Collins's zealous love of life and his selfless concern for the welfare of others distinguished him as an outstanding human being and as a leading citizen. A veteran of the U.S. Marine Corps, he held the posts of patrol officer and detective with the Toledo Police Department, from which he retired after nearly thirty years of service, president of the Toledo Police Patrolman's Association, visiting professor at The University of Toledo, teacher at Lourdes College, director of the Ohio Police Corps, and member of the Toledo City Council before being elected mayor in 2013, and he was instrumental in encouraging ProMedica to move its corporate headquarters to the urban riverfront and in continuing the progress of the Hensville

downtown entertainment district. In addition, his tremendous efforts serve as an inspiration for others, including his wife, Sandy, his three daughters, and his eight grandchildren; and
