A RESOLUTION

In memory of Moinyak "Murray" Ebner.

WHEREAS, The members of the Senate of the 131st General
Assembly of Ohio extend our sincere condolences to the friends and
family of Moinyak "Murray" Ebner; and

WHEREAS, Murray Ebner left an indelible impression on the
people whose lives he touched, and this spirited individual
contributed immeasurably to the world around him. A native of
Poland, he survived internment in the concentration camp at
Auschwitz during the Holocaust, and he later wrote a book and
talked to schoolchildren about his ordeals. Among his endeavors,
he was a U.S. armed forces veteran of the Korean War, the founder
of Ebner Properties, the president of Congregation Agudas Achim,
the president, vice president, and treasurer of Wexner Heritage
Village, and a member of the boards of Columbus Torah Academy and
the Columbus Jewish Historical Society, and he and his family
donated the Holocaust exhibit at the building that houses Jewish
Family Services; and

WHEREAS, Murray Ebner's regard for improving the quality of
life in our society was clearly evident in his personal sacrifices
of time and effort to his family, friends, and community, and his
contributions will certainly live beyond him. The warmth and
understanding he so readily extended to others will stand as a
testament to his personal character, and he will be remembered
fondly by all those who knew and loved him, including his wife,
Sylvia, his three children, Lisa, Mark, and Cynthia, and his six
grandchildren, Gayle, Aaron, Jared, Zachary, Julian, and Sabrina;

WHEREAS, Murray Ebner's zealous love of life and his selfless
concern for the welfare of others distinguished him as an

outstanding human being and as a leading citizen. Giving 29
generously of his energy and abilities in all of his endeavors, he 30
displayed exceptional concern and insight, and although the void 31
his death has created can never be filled, the legacy of care and 32
commitment he established will surely live on; therefore be it 33
