In memory of Charles Lewis Scott.

WHEREAS, The members of the Senate of the 131st General  
Assembly of Ohio offer our deepest sympathy and heartfelt  
condolences to the family and many friends of Charles Lewis Scott  
on the sorrowful occasion of his death; and

WHEREAS, Chuck Scott will long be remembered as a spirited  
individual who contributed immeasurably to the world around him. A  
decorated U.S. Navy veteran of World War II, he commenced his  
career as a photographer with the Illinois Natural History Survey,  
and he served in several capacities with various periodicals,  
including the *Champaign-Urbana Courier*, *The Milwaukee Journal*, and  
the *Chicago Daily News*, and as a visual journalism professor with  
the Ohio University Scripps College of Communication, where he  
helped found the Institute of Visual Communication. In addition,  
he was active with such organizations as the Ohio News  
Photographers Association, The Society of Professional Journalist  
the National Press Photographers Association, The National  
Journalism Honorary, and the National Photojournalism Honorary,  
and he demonstrated an unwavering commitment to his profession, a  
legacy that will surely live on; and

WHEREAS, Although there are no words to ease the sadness now  
felt, surely there is solace in having been touched by such an  
outstanding person as Chuck Scott. The love, compassion, and  
understanding that he so readily extended to others will long  
remain in the hearts and minds of all who loved and cherished him,  
including his two children, Lyntha and Tom, his four stepchildren,  
Betty, Marion, William, and Andrew, his ten grandchildren, Andrew,  
Christina, Natalie, Samantha, Andrew, Margaux, Abigail, Scott,  
Lauren, and Christopher, and his great-granddaughter, Stone; and

WHEREAS, Chuck Scott's concern for improving the quality of 29  
life in our society was clearly evident in the number of honors 30  
bestowed upon him, which include the 1966 Newspaper Editor of the 31  
Year, the 1952 Photographer of the Year, the 1970 Kenneth P. 32  
McLaughlin, the 1975 Joseph A. Sprague, and the 1979 Robin Garland 33  
Photojournalism Educator awards. Giving generously of his time, 34  
energy, and abilities far beyond what was required or expected, he 35  
displayed exceptional concern and insight, and he was tireless in 36  
his efforts to better the world around him; therefore be it 37
