A R E S O L U T I O N

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

WHEREAS, The members of the Senate of the 131st General 4

has requested permission to use the Ohio Senate Chambers for its 6
model legislative event, April 16-18, 2015; and 7
