A RESOLUTION

In memory of Delbert L. Latta.

WHEREAS, The members of the Senate of the 131st General
Assembly of Ohio offer our deepest sympathy and heartfelt
condolences to the family and many friends of Delbert L. Latta on
the sorrowful occasion of his death; and

WHEREAS, Although there are no words to ease the sadness now
felt, surely there is solace in having been touched by such an
outstanding person as Delbert Latta. A veteran of the Ohio
National Guard and the U.S. Army and Marine Corps Reserve, he
served as a lawyer in private practice and a teacher at Ohio
Northern University before being elected to the Ohio Senate in
1952 and the U.S. House of Representatives in 1958, and during his
thirty-year tenure as the representative for Ohio's 5th district,
he served as a member of the Agriculture, Export Controls,
Judiciary, Budget, Rules, and Republican Leadership committees.
The love, compassion, and understanding that he so readily
extended to others, including his wife,
Rose Mary, his two children, Rose and Robert, his five
grandchildren, Peter, David, Andrew, Elizabeth, and Maria, and his
three great-grandchildren, Olivia, Hazel, and Noah, will long
remain in the hearts and minds of all who knew him; and

WHEREAS, Delbert Latta left an indelible impression on the
people whose lives he touched, and he will long be remembered as a
spirited individual who contributed immeasurably to the world

around him. One of state senator Latta's key achievements was 24
leading the effort to develop the Causeway to Cedar Point, which 25
contributed greatly to the growth of one of America's best known 26
theme parks. In addition, he was active with such organizations as 27
the Bowling Green State University, Defiance College, and Ashland 28
College John Ashbrook Center boards of trustees, the American 29
Legion, and McComb Church of Christ, and he demonstrated an 30
unwavering commitment to service--a legacy that will surely live 31
on; and 32

WHEREAS, Delbert Latta's concern for improving the quality of 33
life in our society was clearly evident in the number of accolades 34
and awards bestowed upon him, including having the Delbert L. 35
Latta Post Office Building named in his honor. Giving generously 36
of his time, energy, and abilities far beyond what was required or 37
expected, he displayed exceptional concern and insight and was 38
tireless in his efforts to better the world around him; therefore 39
