A RESOLUTION

In memory of Sean R. Johnson.

WHEREAS, The members of the Senate of the 131st General
Assembly of Ohio were deeply saddened to learn of the death of
Sean R. Johnson and extend our heartfelt condolences to his family
and friends; and

WHEREAS, Sean Johnson left an indelible impression on the
people whose lives he touched, and he will be remembered as a
spirited individual who contributed immeasurably to the world
around him. A veteran of the U.S. Air Force, he served as a member
of the Ohio Attorney General's Office Investigative Unit and a
deputy for the Fairfield County Sheriff's Office before joining
the Hilliard Division of Police sixteen years ago, and he was a
member of its traffic-safety unit and the recipient of several
honors and awards; and

WHEREAS, Giving generously of his energy and abilities, Sean
Johnson displayed exceptional concern and insight and was tireless
in his work to better the world around him. A devoted father to
two children, he always used his talents to the benefit of those
around him, and although the void his death has created can never
be filled, the legacy of care and commitment he established will

own safety, and in fact their lives, to ensure the well-being of
