WHEREAS, The members of the Senate of the 131st General
Assembly of Ohio are deeply saddened to learn of the death of
James F. Carmichael and extend our heartfelt condolences to his
loving wife Carolyn, family and friends; and

WHEREAS, Jim Carmichael left an indelible impression on the
people whose lives he touched, and he will be remembered as a
spirited individual who contributed immeasurably to the world
around him. A veteran of the Ohio National Guard and a
commissioner for Wayne County, he was a former Wooster region
district manager for the Dominion East Ohio Gas Company, mayor of
the Village of Shreve, and member of the Ohio House of
Representatives, where he served as assistant majority whip,
majority whip, assistant majority floor leader, and chairman of
the State Government Committee and the Ohio House and Senate
Cancer Caucus; and

WHEREAS, Jim Carmichael's regard for improving the quality of
life in our society was clearly evident in his personal sacrifices
of time and effort to his family, friends, and community, and he
will be remembered for his generosity, talents, and seemingly
inexhaustible energy. Over the years, he was active with such
organizations as the Wayne County Board of Elections, Republican
Party, Mayor's Association, and Citizens Task Force and the Shreve
Friends of the Library and Fire and Police departments, and he
