Far too often our officers are called upon to initiate life-saving measures of overdose by the administration of Naloxone. I believe that having programs available to those seeking assistance is crucial in fighting this epidemic.

In addition to providing the program itself, I support the grant program which will provide transportation vouchers to those seeking assistance. I feel the attendance rate would increase should this be provided to those who could not otherwise afford the cost of transportation.

In an effort for these programs to be successful, creating a grant program that provides capital funds for Faith-Based Recovery Centers is essential. Having the most powerful forces in our culture is undoubtedly indispensable.
