• Thank you for the opportunity to share with the committee. Today I would like to focus my attention on the importance of father involvement. And particularly as it relates to **infant mortality**, the death of a child before its *first birthday*. I was made aware of this this tragic phenomena about 2-years ago during a meeting with faith leaders in Cleveland. I try toaware of issues in our community, I shocked to learn that Ohio ranked amongst the worse in the **nation at** the time 45th for infant mortality 4

FameFathers and its "#PreciousCargo" initiative is striving to work with fathers and families to help them deliver healthy and safe babies, in order to reduce infant mortality.

Making sure that our fathers are involved and knowledgeable early and throughout the pregnancy is part of the solution.

When fathers **are not** present in a child's life, children are **five** times more likely to *live in poverty* and **twice** as likely to *abuse drugs*, be *abused and neglected*, and develop *emotional or behavior problems*.

When dads are involved in their child's life from the beginning, they are more likely to stay engaged in the child's entire life.
