At the age of 16 I went to work for a man that asked if he could pay me in half money and half drugs. He also told me how much money I could make selling drugs. It lead me to a life of selling and using drugs for over 40 years. The only time I did not use drugs was when I was incarcerated. Drugs took over my life.

Once I starting trying to recovery I had no way of paying for treatment. I was put out of treatment programs for a lack of payment. I developed many physical complications due to my use. The only treatment I could get was in the emergency rooms. The emergency room cannot turn anyone away. In 2014, someone told me to apply for Medicaid, I had applied before and was not eligible and I was doubtful that I would be eligible this time. However, I applied and was accepted. The first thing I did was to get a doctor and get my physical conditions cared for. I need blood thinners and treatment for Hepatices C. In addition, to getting my physical health care treated, this past August I took the courageous step and went into UMADAOP for drug treatment. UMADAOP has saved my life but they would not have been able to without Medicaid expansion. I am pleading that you do not eliminate the expansion program. There are many many people like myself depending on Medicaid for insurance.
