Kim, who lost his life in the line of duty on June 19th, 2015, while responding to a call in the Madisonville neighborhood. As a veteran officer, he served the Cincinnati Police Department with dignity and honor for nearly three decades and earned 21 letters of appreciation and/or commendation.

Officer Kim’s service to his community went beyond his duty as a police officer. He provided mentorship and guidance to the local youth who attended his Japanese Karate dojo.
