Tariq Mohamed is the Business and Employment Services Coordinator for the New Country / New Job pod at Jewish Family Services. Tariq received the Employee of the Year award from JFS in 2010, because he manages a team, which has placed over 2,500 clients in his eleven year tenure. In addition, Tariq has managed over 70 hiring events, and has created successful job search strategies for the ever changing refugee population in Central Ohio. Throughout his career, Tariq has served as a liaison between employers and refugees, offering cultural training to refugees to prepare them for the workplace, but also to employers, to help them understand how to manage this strategically important labor force. Tariq has also promoted cultural understanding through photography. In 2006, Tariq's show, Forlorn in Ohio was presented by Kiaca Gallery in Columbus, and in 2011 his film, War, War and Resettlement: Nasro's Journey was shown on WOSU, the local PBS affiliate.
