RESEARCH:

Experience:

I have been the project coordinator in a multi-institutional collaborative research project that surveyed fifteen hospitals affiliated with medical schools, each of which had received a Transfusion Medicine Academic Award.

I completed a literature review and helped to design a questionnaire in order to gather data concerning the hospitals' indications and procedural guidelines with regard to neonatal transfusions. Data was entered and analyzed in a computerized database. Dr. Melanie Kennedy, Associate Dean, was my supervisor. I was awarded a Transfusion Medicine Student Research Clerkship for this project.

Also, I was the primary investigator in a research project through the Department of General Surgery working with Dr. Mark Arnold and Dr. Edward Martin. The purpose of this study was to determine the efficacy of pre-operative abdominal CT scans in predicting the necessity of an exploratory laparotomy in a questionable recurrence of colon cancer in RIGS patients.

Recently I was an investigator for a project entitled "A Multicenter Placebo-Controlled Trial of Imipramine versus Paroxetine in Adolescent Depression."
