A BILL

To amend section 517.073 of the Revised Code to	1
require a township to compensate the owner of	2
certain unused cemetery lots and rights which	3
the township reenters after lack of response	4
from the owner.	5

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 517.073 of the Revised Code be	6
amended to read as follows:	7
Sec. 517.073. (A) The board of township trustees may	8
reenter a lot for which the terms of sale or deed was executed	9
prior to <u>before</u> July 24, 1986, or an entombment, including a	10
mausoleum, columbarium, or other interment right for which the	11
terms of sale or deed was executed prior to <u>b</u>efore September 29,	12
2015, if the board determines the lot or right is unused and	13
adopts a resolution creating a procedure for right of reentry in	14
accordance with this section. The resolution shall state that	15
the board of township trustees has the right of reentry to the	16
cemetery lot or right purchased prior to <u>before</u> July 24, 1986,	17
or prior to <u>before</u> September 29, 2015. Before reentering a lot	18

or right, the board shall send a notice by certified mail to the 19 last known owner at the owner's last known address to inform the 20 owner that the owner's interest in the lot or right will cease 21 unless the owner or owner's heir responds by a specified date. 22 If the owner's address is unknown and cannot be obtained 23 reasonably, it is sufficient to publish the notice once in a 24 25 newspaper of general circulation in the county. To establish reentry, the board shall pass a resolution stating that the 26 owner has not responded by the specified date, and that the 27 board reclaims its interest in the lot or right. The board shall 28 compensate owners of unused lots or rights who respond after the 29 specified date by providing the owner an available lot or right, 30 as applicable, at no cost. If a lot or right, as applicable, is 31 not available or if the owner declines the lot or right, the 32 board shall compensate the owner by paying the owner eighty per 33 cent of the owner's original purchase price. The board may 34 repurchase a cemetery lot or right from its owner at any time at 35 a price that is mutually agreed upon by the board and the owner. 36

(B) At least ninety days prior to the before a termination 37 date for use of the a cemetery lot for which the terms of sale 38 or deed was executed before July 24, 1986, and contained a 39 termination date, tomb or an entombment, including a mausoleum, 40 or columbarium, for which the terms of sale or deed was executed 41 before September 29, 2015, and contained a termination date, the 42 board shall send a notice to the owner of an unused lot or right 43 to inform the owner that the owner's interest in the lot or 44 right will cease on the termination date unless the owner or 45 owner's heir contracts for renewal by that date. The board shall 46 send the notice by certified mail to the owner if the owner is a 47 resident of the township or is a nonresident whose address is 48 known. If the owner's address is unknown and cannot reasonably 49 be obtained, it is sufficient to publish the notice once in a 50 newspaper of general circulation in the county. 51 In order to establish reentry, the board shall pass a 52 53 resolution stating that because of the lack of response to notice sent by certified mail that provided a termination date, 54 the board reclaims its interest in the lot or right. The board 55 shall compensate owners of unused lots or rights who respond 56 after the termination date by providing the owner an available 57 lot or right, as applicable, at no cost. If a lot or right, as 58 applicable, is not available or if the owner declines the lot or 59 right, the board shall compensate the owner by paying the owner 60 eighty per cent of the owner's original purchase price. The 61 board may repurchase a cemetery lot or right from its owner at 62 any time at a price that is mutually agreed upon by the board 63 and the owner. 64 Section 2. That existing section 517.073 of the Revised 65 Code is hereby repealed. 66
