BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 2923.25 of the Revised Code be	9
amended to read as follows:	10
Sec. 2923.25. (A) As used in this section:	11
(1) "Federally licensed firearms dealer" has the same	12
meaning as in section 5502.63 of the Revised Code.	13
(2) "Authorized under law for a firearm transfer" means	14
with respect to a specified person either or both of the	15
following:	16
(a) That a federally licensed firearms dealer has complied	17

with 18 U.S.C. 922(t) regarding a potential sale or transfer of		
a firearm to the person and the transfer of the firearm to the		
person is not prohibited under that provision.		
(b) That the sale or transfer of a firearm to the person	21	
is not prohibited under any provision of federal law or the law	22	
<u>of this state.</u>		
(B)(1) A federally licensed firearms dealer may refuse, in	24	
the dealer's discretion, to sell or otherwise transfer a firearm	25	
to any person.	26	
(2) The right of a federally licensed firearms dealer to	27	
refuse to sell or otherwise transfer a firearm to a person that	28	
is granted under division (B)(1) of this section applies	29	
regardless of whether the person to whom the sale or transfer is	30	
refused is authorized under law for a firearm transfer.		
(3) A federally licensed firearms dealer who refuses to	32	
sell or otherwise transfer a firearm to a person under the right	33	
granted under division (B)(1) of this section is immune from any		
civil liability for any injury, death, or loss to person or	35	
property that allegedly was caused by, resulted from, or was	36	
related to the refusal to sell or otherwise transfer the firearm		
to the person.		
(C) Each federally licensed firearms dealer who sells any	39	
firearm, at the time of the sale of the firearm, shall offer for	40	
sale to the purchaser of the firearm a trigger lock, gun lock,		
or gun locking device that is appropriate for that firearm. Each		
federally licensed firearms dealer shall post in a conspicuous		
location in the dealer's place of business the poster furnished		

to the dealer pursuant to section 5502.63 of the Revised Code

and shall make available to all purchasers of firearms from the

dealer the brochure furnished to the dealer pursuant to that	47

As used in this section, "federally licensed firearms-	49
dealer" has the same meaning as in section 5502.63 of the	50
Revised Code.
