**A BILL**

To amend section 742.07 of the Revised Code to 1  
require the Ohio Police and Fire Pension Fund 2  
Board of Trustees to elect a retirant member as 3  
chairperson every third year. 4

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:**

**Section 1.** That section 742.07 of the Revised Code be 5  
amended to read as follows: 6

**Sec. 742.07.** Within three months after all of the first 7  
appointed members of the board of trustees of the Ohio police 8  
and fire pension fund have been appointed and qualified, the 9  
governor shall call the first meeting of the board, and 10  
thereafter meetings of the board shall be called in such manner 11  
and at such times as the board prescribes, provided, that the 12  
board shall meet at least four times annually. All meetings of 13  
the board shall be open to the public except executive sessions 14  
as set forth in division (G) of section 121.22 of the Revised 15  
Code, and any portions of any sessions discussing medical 16  
records or the degree of disability of a member excluded from 17  
public inspection by section 742.41 of the Revised Code. 18

At its first meeting the board shall organize by electing 19  
from its membership a chairperson and a vice-chairperson who 20  
shall serve for a term of one year. Annually thereafter, the 21  
board shall elect from ~~its membership~~ the members who are 22  
employee members and retirant members a chairperson and a vice- 23  
chairperson for a term of one year. At the first election for 24  
chairperson that follows the effective date of this amendment, 25  
and every third year thereafter, the members of the board shall 26  
elect either the firefighter retirant member or the police 27  
retirant member to serve as chairperson. 28

A majority of the full membership of the board shall 29  
constitute a quorum. 30

**Section 2.** That existing section 742.07 of the Revised 31  
Code is hereby repealed. 32
