A RESOLUTION

In memory of Officer Anthony Morelli.

WHEREAS, The members of the Senate of the 132nd General 1

Officer Anthony Morelli and extend our heartfelt condolences to 3

WHEREAS, Anthony Morelli left an indelible impression on the 5
people whose lives he touched, and he will be remembered as a 6
spirited individual who contributed immeasurably to the world 7
around him. A thirty-year veteran of the Westerville Division of 8
Police, he was the recipient of numerous accolades, including the 9
2012 Officer of the Year Award, and he was killed in the line of 10
duty on February 10, 2018. His contributions to his profession 11
were, indeed, noteworthy; and 12

WHEREAS, Giving generously of his energy and abilities, 13
Anthony Morelli displayed exceptional concern and insight, and he 14
was tireless in his efforts to better the world around him. 15
Without a doubt, he was a devoted husband to his wife, Linda, and 16

the benefit of others. Although the void his death has created can 18
never be filled, the legacy of care and commitment he established 19
will surely live on, and his absence will be keenly felt; and 20

their fellow citizens. The devotion to duty that Anthony Morelli 24
