

I oppose House Bill 680 since it rolls back in person early voting and end statewide mail-in ballot applications for the upcoming November election. I believe we should support instead a provision for mail-in voting for all the citizens of the state of Ohio. This would be the first presidential election since 2008 in which our state would not mail an unsolicited absentee ballot application to all registered voters.
