Hello,

The purpose of this testimony to express support for the immediate passage of S.B.311.

As a private citizen and resident of OHIO, I feel the Governor, via the ODH and other state agencies have exceeded their constitutional and legislative authority and have continued to act in defiance of the rulings of various Ohio Courts during the past 8 months.
