Thank you for the opportunity to provide testimony in support of Substitute House Bill 2 regarding the TechCred Program. I am Jennifer Meek Eells, President of the Ohio Workforce Association.

The OWA represents 20 local Workforce Development Boards across Ohio. There are 245 local businesses represented across these Boards, as well as 28 Business Organizations and more than 40 labor representatives.
