My name is Carol Hasek. I am a mother, grandmother, former contract security manager and retired coordinator for a volunteer mentoring program which served five Cleveland schools.

I retired after 26 years with Securitas Security Services. My responsibilities included training and scheduling armed and unarmed security officers at various locations in Northern Ohio, including two schools systems, banks, retail, multi-use office and housing, and manufacturing facilities.

Guns do not belong in our schools.

I oppose any legislation that does not serve to reduce the number of guns found in our community.

I absolutely oppose this legislation which would enable untrained teachers or administrators to carry weapons in our schools.
