

Please note. I originally sent a witness form on April 7, 2019 for the April 10<sup>th</sup> hearing. I am submitting this additional testimony for the April 24<sup>th</sup> hearing.

Why does Ohio need this bill? It doesn't it. It's a solution in search of a problem.
