As the inaugural Chairman of the Board, I was responsible for the formal creation of the National Institute for Public Safety Technology. I continue to offer leadership and strategic direction as the organization's Executive Director. As Chairman and Executive Director, I was intimately involved in the project management and development of Live CAD. The purpose of the Live CAD framework is to overcome common jurisdictional information barriers that inhibit the flow of critical information to emergency service professionals. The end result is the ability of dispatchers and first responders to have visibility into mission-critical information regardless of jurisdictional affiliation. More than 7 regional 9-1-1 centers and 4,000 users in the Central Ohio region currently use Live CAD in the course of their duties.

In addition to Live CAD, NIPST is also proud to offer MECC Map, an in-vehicle GIS system used by more than 100 fire departments throughout Ohio. To date, MECC Map is the most widely used emergency services mapping system in Ohio.
