**A BILL**

To enact section 5.52 of the Revised Code to 1  
designate August 31 as "Frank Robinson Day." 2

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:**

**Section 1.** That section 5.52 of the Revised Code be 3  
enacted to read as follows: 4

Sec. 5.52. The thirty-first day of August is designated as 5  
"Frank Robinson Day," in honor of the major league baseball 6  
player, manager, and executive, who was born on that day in 7  
1935. Frank Robinson was named manager of the Cleveland Indians 8  
in 1975, and thereby became the first African-American manager 9  
in major league baseball. 10
