BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 3/1/.22 of the Revised Code be	5
amended to read as follows:	6
Sec. 3717.22. (A) The following are not retail food	7
establishments:	8
(1) A food service operation licensed under this chapter,	9
including a food service operation that provides the services of	10
a retail food establishment pursuant to an endorsement issued	11
under section 3717.44 of the Revised Code;	12
(2) An entity exempt under divisions (B)(1) to (9) or (11)	13
to (13) of section 3717.42 of the Revised Code from the	14
requirement to be licensed as a food service operation and an	15
entity exempt under division (B)(10) of that section if the	16
entity is regulated by the department of agriculture as a food	17
processing establishment under section 3715.021 of the Revised	18

Code;	19
(3) A business or that portion of a business that is	20
regulated by the federal government or the department of	21
agriculture as a food manufacturing or food processing business,	22
including a business or that portion of a business regulated by	23
the department of agriculture under Chapter 911., 913., 915.,	24
917., 918., or 925. of the Revised Code.	25
(B) All of the following are exempt from the requirement	26
to be licensed as a retail food establishment:	27
(1) An establishment with commercially prepackaged foods	28
that are not potentially hazardous and contained in displays,	29
the total space of which equals less than two hundred cubic	30
feet;	31
(2) A person at a farmers market that is registered with	32
the director of agriculture pursuant to section 3717.221 of the	33
Revised Code that offers for sale only one or more of the	34
following:	35
(a) Fresh unprocessed fruits or vegetables;	36
(b) Products of a cottage food production operation;	37
(c) Maple syrup, sorghum, honey, apple syrup, or apple	38
butter that is produced by a maple syrup or sorghum producer,	39
beekeeper, or apple syrup or apple butter processor described in	40
division (A) of section 3715.021 of the Revised Code;	41
(d) Wine as authorized under section 4303.2010 of the	42
Revised Code;	43
(e) Commercially prepackaged food that is not potentially	44
hazardous, on the condition that the food is contained in	45
displays, the total space of which equals less than one hundred	46

cubic feet on the premises where the person conducts business at	47
the farmers market.	48
(3) A person who offers for sale at a roadside stand only	49
fresh fruits and fresh vegetables that are unprocessed;	50
(4) A nonprofit organization exempt from federal income	51
taxation under section 501(c)(3) of the "Internal Revenue Code	52
of 1986," 100 Stat. 2085, 26 U.S.C.A. 1, as amended, that raises	53
funds by selling foods and that, if required to be licensed,	54
would be classified as risk level one in accordance with rules	55
establishing licensing categories for retail food establishments	56
adopted under section 3717.33 of the Revised Code, if the sales	57
occur inside a building and are for not more than seven	58
consecutive days or more than fifty-two separate days during a	59
licensing period. This exemption extends to any individual or	60
group raising all of its funds during the time periods specified	61
in division (B)(4) of this section for the benefit of the	62
nonprofit organization by selling foods under the same	63
conditions.	64
(5) An establishment that offers food contained in	65
displays of less than five hundred square feet, and if required	66
to be licensed would be classified as risk level one pursuant to	67
rules establishing licensing categories for retail food	68
establishments adopted under section 3717.33 of the Revised	69
Code, on the condition that the establishment offers the food	70
for sale at retail not more than six months in each calendar	71
year;	72
(6) A cottage food production operation, on the condition	73
that the operation offers its products directly to the consumer	74
from the site where the products are produced;	75

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(7) A maple syrup and sorghum processor, beekeeper, or	76
apple syrup and apple butter processor described in division (A)	77
of section 3715.021 of the Revised Code, on the condition that	78
the processor or beekeeper offers only maple syrup, sorghum,	79
honey, apple syrup, or apple butter directly to the consumer	80
from the site where those products are processed;	81
(8) A person who annually maintains five hundred or fewer	82
birds, on the condition that the person offers the eggs from	83
those birds directly to the consumer from the location where the	84
eggs are produced or at a farm product auction to which division	85
(B) (11) of this section applies;	86
(9) A person who annually raises and slaughters one	87
thousand or fewer chickens, on the condition that the person	88
offers dressed chickens directly to the consumer from the	89
location where the chickens are raised and slaughtered or at a	90
farm product auction to which division (B)(11) of this section	91
applies;	92
(10) A person who raises, slaughters, and processes the	93
meat of nonamenable species described in divisions (A) and (B)	94
of section 918.12 of the Revised Code, on the condition that the	95
person offers the meat directly to the consumer from the	96
location where the meat is processed or at a farm product	97
auction to which division (B)(11) of this section applies;	98
(11) A farm product auction, on the condition that it is	99
registered with the director pursuant to section 3717.221 of the	100
Revised Code that offers for sale at the farm product auction	101
only one or more of the following:	102
(a) The products described in divisions (B)(8) to (10) of	103
this section that are produced, raised, slaughtered, or	104

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processed, as appropriate, by persons described in divisions (B)	105
(8) to (10) of this section;	106
(b) Fresh unprocessed fruits or vegetables;	107
(c) Products of a cottage food production operation;	108
(d) Maple syrup, sorghum, honey, apple syrup, or apple	109
butter that is produced by a maple syrup or sorghum producer,	110
beekeeper, or apple syrup or apple butter processor described in	111
division (A) of section 3715.021 of the Revised Code.	112
(12) An establishment that, with respect to offering food	113
for sale, offers only alcoholic beverages or prepackaged	114
beverages that are not potentially hazardous;	115
(13) An establishment that, with respect to offering food	116
for sale, offers only alcoholic beverages, prepackaged beverages	117
that are not potentially hazardous, or commercially prepackaged	118
food that is not potentially hazardous, on the condition that	119
the commercially prepackaged food is contained in displays, the	120
total space of which equals less than two hundred cubic feet on	121
the premises of the establishment;	122
(14) An establishment that, with respect to offering food	123
for sale, offers only fountain beverages that are not	124
potentially hazardous;	125
(15) A person who offers for sale only one or more of the	126
following foods at a festival or celebration, on the condition	127
that the festival or celebration is organized by a political	128
subdivision of the state and lasts for a period not longer than	129
seven consecutive days:	130
(a) Fresh unprocessed fruits or vegetables;	131
(b) Products of a cottage food production operation;	132

(c) Maple syrup, sorghum, honey, apple syrup, or apple	133
butter if produced by a maple syrup or sorghum processor,	134
beekeeper, or apple syrup or apple butter processor as described	135
in division (A) of section 3715.021 of the Revised Code;	136
(d) Commercially prepackaged food that is not potentially	137
hazardous, on the condition that the food is contained in	138
displays, the total space of which equals less than one hundred	139
cubic feet;	140
(e) Fruit butter produced at the festival or celebration	141
and sold from the production site.	142
(16) A farm market on the condition that it is registered	143
with the director pursuant to section 3717.221 of the Revised	144
Code that offers for sale at the farm market only one or more of	145
the following:	146
(a) Fresh unprocessed fruits or vegetables;	147
(b) Products of a cottage food production operation;	148
(c) Maple syrup, sorghum, honey, apple syrup, or apple	149
butter that is produced by a maple syrup or sorghum producer,	150
beekeeper, or apple syrup or apple butter processor described in	151
division (A) of section 3715.021 of the Revised Code;	152
(d) Commercially prepackaged food that is not potentially	153
hazardous, on the condition that the food is contained in	154
displays, the total space of which equals less than one hundred	155
cubic feet on the premises where the person conducts business at	156
the farm market;	157
(e) Cider and other juices manufactured on site at the	158
<pre>farm market;</pre>	159
(f) The products or items described in divisions (B)(8) to	160

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(10) of this section, on the condition that those products or	161
items were produced by the person offering to sell them, and	162
further conditioned that, with respect to eggs offered, the	163
person offering to sell them annually maintains five hundred or	164
fewer birds, and with respect to dressed chickens offered, the	165
person annually raises and slaughters one thousand or fewer	166
chickens.	167
(17)(a) An establishment to which all of the following	168
apply:	169
(i) The establishment serves commercially prepackaged food_	170
in a form that prevents direct human contact prior to and during	171
service;	172
(ii) Sales of the prepackaged food do not exceed more than	173
five per cent of the total gross receipts of the establishment;	174
(iii) The establishment has been issued an A-2 permit	175
under section 4303.03 or an A-2f permit under section 4303.031	176
of the Revised Code and annually produces ten thousand gallons	177
or less of wine;	178
(b) The owner or operator of the establishment shall	179
notify the director that it is exempt from licensure because it	180
qualifies under division (B) (17) (a) of this section. The owner	181
or operator also shall disclose to customers that the	182
establishment is exempt from licensure.	183
Section 2. That existing section 3717.22 of the Revised	184
Code is hereby repealed.	185
